Solebury School will:

- Notify the community of a positive COVID diagnosis for students or employees
- Disclose positive diagnoses to Bucks County DoH and State of Pennsylvania

Situation		Quarantine/Isolation
Community member tests (+)	Symptomatic	10 days from start of symptoms
	Asymptomatic	10 days from date of + test
Vaccinated community member is a close contact of a confirmed (+) case	Symptomatic	rapid ag test after symptoms begin: confirm (-) with PCR, may return to campus 24 hrs after symptoms improve if both tests (-)
	Asymptomatic	none; must wear mask in all public areas and monitor for symptoms for 14 days or until a negative test on day 3-5
Unvaccinated community member is a close contact of a confirmed (+) case	Symptomatic	rapid ag test immediately, and again on day 5: confirm (-) with PCR; if all tests (-) may return to campus as early as day 8 if symptoms have resolved for 24+ hrs; continue to wear mask in all public areas and monitor symptoms for 14 days
	Asymptomatic	rapid ag test immediately, and again on day 5; if both tests (-) may return to campus as early as day 8 if remaining asymptomatic; continue to wear mask in all public areas and monitor for symptoms for 14 days
