The Student's responsibilities include:

1. Promote and monitor students' attendance and tardies. Issue tardy slips at 8:10. If a student accumulates more than 3 tardies, he/she will not be eligible for an award per six weeks.
2. Provide a high quality curriculum in a supporting, secure, safe, and effective environment that enables the children served to meet the State's student performance standards.
3. Discuss with parents their responsibilities for supporting improved achievement.
4. Inform parents and students the purpose of the curriculum and district timelines, students' performance standards, and the instruction the school will provide to enable students to achieve the states standard.
5. Scheduling Parent/Teacher conference and maintain two-way communication with parents and model professionalism at all times.
6. Provide opportunities for parents to volunteer/or observe in classrooms.
7. Train teachers and other staff on the latest instructional strategies and methodologies to maintain and improve a positive learning environment in the school.
8. Hold virtual meetings for parent in the morning/day/evening.
9. Be responsive to students and parents during at-home instruction.

1. Ensuring that their children are in school every day, no later than 8:05 a.m. If a student accumulates more than 3 tardies, he/she will not be eligible for an award per six weeks.
2. Follow standardized dress code as per district policy.
3. Teaching and modeling respect and responsibilities at all times.
4. Establish a schedule to ensure that their child completes homework/lessons/projects, etc.
5. Encouraging positive use of their children's spare time such as, reading alone or with family.
6. Call in all absence at, 698-0378. Upon student's return, provide medical excuses and or hand written excuses (no more than 5 per school year).
7. Ensuring student's backpacks are free from any toys, cards, etc.
8. Limiting the amount of TV, electronic devices and video games, etc.
9. Participating in decisions related to the education of their children. Monitor their academic progress through Home Access Center; Progress/Report Cards.
10. Providing appropriate nourishment and rest for the physical well-being of their children.
11. Attending Parent/Teacher conference and maintain communication with their teacher and attend Family Engagement activities.
