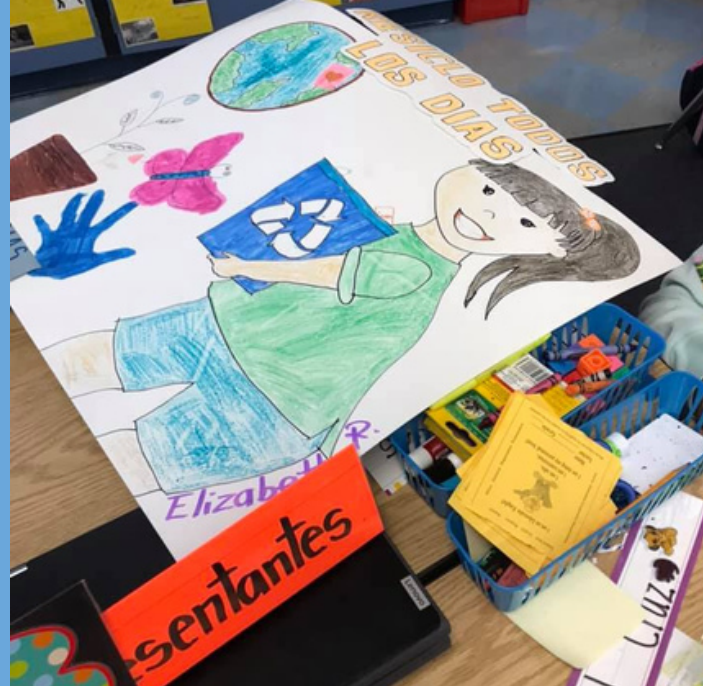

THE PROGRAM

Dual Language Immersion is a unique educational model where children learn to think, read, write and communicate naturally in two languages: English and Spanish. Native Spanish and native English speaking students study both languages beginning in TK/K through 8th grade, to be biliterate in both languages.

We offer two Dual Language programs to choose from:

Two-Way Bilingual Immersion (TWBI) Del Roble and Christopher

Two-Way Bilingual Immersion is a program option in OGSD. Applications are through the Program Option Applications for TK and K only. This is for Native Spanish and native English speaking students. Students in grades other than TK and K can enter on a case by case basis.

One-Way Bilingual Immersion Edenvale

The State Seal of Biliteracy recognizes students who have studied and attained proficiency in two or more languages by high school. At Oak Grove School District, we created a pathway for students to be recognized for their successful academic achievement in English and Spanish. Students who participate in our Dual Language programs will have the opportunity to obtain the Pathway to the Seal of Biliteracy Award.

The intent of this award is to encourage students to continue their journey towards biliteracy as they progress through middle school. Students who meet this local criteria will be granted the Pathway to the Seal of Biliteracy Award at the end of fifth and eighth grade.
