

HONORS in Technical Theatre

Students interested in HONORS in Technical Theatre must have an interview with the Director of Theatre, write an essay highlighting their interests in the field, and complete a resume of academic and extracurricular theatre activities, by the end of his or her 9th-grade year.

Prerequisites

HONORS candidates will:

- Enroll in Theatre classes for at least two terms in each of their 10th, 11th, and 12th grade years: *Stagecraft I, Introduction to Theatre, Technical Theatre Workshop* (Two Terms), *Honors Seminar* (Two Terms). Workshops may include: *Theatre History, Theatre Production, Script Analysis, Stage Design, Lighting for the Stage, Sound Design, Costume Design, and Stage Makeup.*
- Participate in at least two of the three Theatre productions in each of these years.
- Qualify for the Fine Arts Society by the end of the Junior Year.

Honors Seminar

The Honors in Theatre Seminar, meeting twice weekly for two terms, must be taken by candidates for HONORS in their 12th-grade year.

Honors Project

Each candidate must complete a capstone project for the Winter or Spring production of their 12th-grade year.
