



### **The School Shop**

School uniform is only available from the School Shop. Mrs Bowles, our School Shop Manager, operates an appointment system for fittings, which take approximately one hour. Alternatively if you would prefer your uniform mailed to you this can be arranged. Parcels are sent by courier and the cost can be quoted for you at the time and added to your uniform bill. If you prefer to use this method, a size chart will need to be completed and enough time allowed (particularly for overseas students). Please contact Mrs Bowles to make these arrangements.

The Shop is situated within the School and is generally open throughout the year except for two weeks during the Summer Holiday and National Holidays. The Shop will be closed from Saturday 24th July to Sunday 8th August 2021 inclusive.

We kindly request that families living overseas book their appointments early as space is limited and your daughter is expected to start the new school term in uniform. If you are flying into the UK ahead of the beginning of term, we respectfully ask that you make an appointment to have your uniform fitting first. Appointments will <u>not</u> be available on the Induction Day (Monday 6th September). Please e-mail sbowles@mayfieldgirls.org for an appointment.

### **Payments**

Payment can be made by credit card, BACS transfers, cash or cheque. We regret that cheques can only be accepted when drawn on a UK Bank Account.

### **Naming of Uniform**

We offer a sew-on service for name tapes at a one-off charge of £80.00 per pupil. This covers all items of uniform to be named (including socks and tights) for the entire time that your daughter is at Mayfield (i.e. Years 7 to 13).

The School Shop needs to hold a supply of name tapes for each girl, and details of the costs can be obtained from Mrs Bowles. These will be ordered automatically for new entrants using the sew-on service unless we are otherwise informed, and added to your bill. If you are supplying your own name tapes, but still want the sew-on service, please bring them with you when you first visit the Shop to purchase uniform.

Please note that all items of uniform, equipment and other possessions brought into School **must** be clearly named. Boarders **must** have all home clothes named.

- 3. Source your own self-impression mouth guard.

### **Sports Choices**

All sports offered at Mayfield (with the exception of Equestrian which is optional) are compulsory for Years 7 through to 9 and girls will therefore need the entire kit. In Years 10 and 11 you may choose sports options, therefore you need only buy equipment for those sports in which you are participating. Please advise us of your sports options at the time of fitting or buy just the basic kit needed and purchase hockey equipment or swimming equipment only when you know you will be taking one of those options.

### **Miscellaneous**

### Naming clothing and belongings

All items of uniform and home clothes must be named with a sew-on name tape. Name tapes are usually in blue capitals but if you wish you may choose a different font/colour. All equipment must be named with an adhesive name tape or with indelible ink. Other items such as asthma pumps etc. must also be named. It is important that all belongings are **clearly** named so that all lost/mislaid possessions can then be returned to their owners.

### **Jewellery**

All girls may wear a watch, clearly engraved or permanently marked with the owner's name, a cross or religious medal and chain, and one simple ear stud in each ear for those with pierced ears. No other jewellery may be worn in School.

### **Stationery and Calculators**

Stationery is available throughout the year in the School Shop. Below is a basic stationery list as a guideline for your daughters. They may bring their items in any kind of pencil case they wish, but will also require a clear pencil case when sitting exams (these can be purchased in the School Shop or stationery stores). The School will indicate where other stationery may be needed for certain subjects. You may already have these items, or you can source them in the School Shop or High Street stationery stores.

The Maths Department request that all girls use the same model calculator, the Casio FX 83 or 85 GTX up to Year 11. Please note these are upgraded models and if students have the older version (FX83 or 85 Plus) they do not need to upgrade to the newer model.

For those taking A Level Maths in Years 12 and 13 we recommend the FX991EX — all are available in the Shop. For Further Maths students, the School recommends the FX CG50 Casio, which we can order on your behalf and add to your bill on request.

### **Laptop**

All girls are expected to have a laptop for school. This will be used in class as well as for study. A keyboard is essential and a write-on facility is advantageous. Please see the separate Computer Specification Information sheet for more detail and P18 of the General Information section of this booklet.

# SIXTH FORM DRESS CODE 2021 - 2022



### **Purpose**

The way we dress significantly affects our frame of mind, so it is very important to dress in a way that promotes the right attitude for positive learning. Furthermore, as senior members of the School, all girls in the Sixth Form are role models to the younger members of the School, in their appearance as well as in all other areas. Therefore, they should always be both smart and modest.

Sixth Form dress should be equivalent to smart work attire: classic, rather than fashionable, and not what a student would expect to wear when relaxing at home, during the holidays, on the beach, for evening engagements or at university. Outfits should not distract the students, or anyone else, from work.

Whilst it is important that each individual Sixth Former is able, in part, to reflect her individuality in her dress, she is still expected to reflect her membership of the School community with an appropriate level of formality. It is to be hoped that the individuality of each girl is nurtured in all that she does at School, and this is not simply restricted to her appearance.

### **Dress Code: What to Wear**

- Girls must wear a smart skirt, dress or trousers. These should be classic in fit and not made of stretch fabric. Suits may be worn but are not compulsory.
- Skirts/dresses must be, at least, as long as the full extent of the fingertips when standing up straight, with relaxed shoulders and arms stretched downwards.
- Each girl must have a smart, dark tailored jacket which is at least waist length (no denim or leather).
- Girls must wear shirts, blouses, polo necks or smart t-shirts that do not display logos.
- Shoes, boots and sandals must be formal in style and of a sensible and safe height, and purchased before the start of term.
- School wear may be of any colour, but should be without tears or rips.
- Correct School kit must be worn for sport.

Please ensure that all home clothes and all other possessions are named.

All girls should have smart and appropriate clothes and shoes (i.e. no denim, jeans, leggings, jeggings, short skirts or sports kit) for Chapel and formal occasions such as a smart jacket and knee length skirt or trousers as outlined above.

Boarders travel to and from School in home clothes.

### **General Information (all year groups)**

### **Bags and suitcases**

Girls must only use small or medium lightweight bags or suitcases for travelling and storage during holidays. We do not permit large bags, suitcases or trunks as these can be very heavy and difficult to handle. Luggage is handled by girls, staff and taxi drivers and must be of a manageable size and weight.

### Storage of belongings during holidays

Girls may leave some possessions in School during the holidays. Only one suitcase and one bag can be stored during the holidays due to limited storage space in the Houses. Suitable bags are available to buy in the School Shop or you may use your own.

### Laundry

A laundry bag and book will be supplied by the Boarding Housemistress. Uniform, home clothes and bedding can be sent to an outside laundry and it is essential that **everything is clearly named**. We recommend that girls do not bring clothes which need individual wash care (e.g. hand wash) as the laundry cannot accommodate such requirements. Your Housemistress will give you details of the laundry procedure. Boarding Houses have washing and drying machines for girls' use. All clothes to be washed in-house must be machine washable and able to go in a tumble dryer.

#### **Valuables**

It is strongly advised that any personal jewellery and other valuables for use out of school hours should be engraved or permanently marked with the owner's name. All items of value should be kept in the secure locker provided in the Boarding House when not in use. We ask that you please name expensive items such as laptops and phones.

Please do not bring valuable jewellery to School.

#### **School Account**

The first purchase of uniform (new or nearly new), stationery and the sew-on service must be paid for at the time of ordering and any alternative arrangements to this must first be cleared with the Bursar. If you are travelling from abroad and not accompanying your daughter, a deposit can be left with the School Shop to cover this initial purchase. Once your daughter commences School there is an account set up for her in the School Shop and she may place items of uniform, stationery, toiletries and a small selection of Mayfield gifts on the account, which is then billed to you termly. All purchases are made on trust by your daughter and it is assumed that you have given your daughter clear instructions or guidelines for placing items on your account. ### **Stationery and Calculators**

Stationery is available throughout the year in the School Shop. For A Level Maths the FX-991EX is recommended and available to purchase in the School Shop. For Further Maths students, the School recommends the FX-CG50 Casio. This can be ordered from the School Shop and takes 2 –4 days to come in.

#### **Price List**

A current price list of uniform is available from the School Shop. Please e-mail **sbowles@mayfieldgirls.org** if you would like to see this. Please note this is subject to change without notice.

#### **Second Hand Uniform**

A small amount of second hand uniform is available all year round from the School Shop, but availability varies. If you intend to stock up with second hand uniform for the start of the new academic year, we advise booking an appointment in June or July to avoid disappointment. You will be billed separately for this.

If you have second hand uniform to sell, this must be returned washed and ironed to the School Shop. Any items marked, with holes, rips, in general poor condition or unwashed will be sent for recycling and no credit will be given. Any items accepted for second hand will be credited to the next available bill regardless of whether we sell them or not.

### **Fittings**

As fittings can take up to an hour and a half, and we are usually fully booked over the Summer, we would like to make your time with us as productive as possible. To that end, we would kindly request that siblings do not attend the fittings with your daughter, and thank you in advance for your understanding. In the event of an emergency or, if you simply do not have alternate sitting facilities available to you, we can make exceptions, but older children may be asked to wait in our reception area.

### **Naming Clothing and Belongings**

All items of uniform and home clothes <u>must be named</u> with a sew-on name tape. Name tapes are usually in blue capitals but different fonts/colour are acceptable. All equipment must be named with an adhesive name tape or with indelible ink. Other items such as asthma inhalers must also be named. It is important that all belongings are *clearly* named so that all lost/mislaid possessions can then be returned to their owners.

### **Jewellery**

All girls may wear a watch, clearly engraved or permanently marked with the owner's name, a cross or religious medal and chain, one simple ear stud in each ear (for those with pierced ears). No other jewellery may be worn in School.

### **Apps and Digital Storage**

The Systems Department advise the backing up of all pupils data held on devices such as smartphones, laptops, tablets and desktops. Device manufacturers generally offer free Cloud or iCloud backup services. Alternatively, consider using Google Drive 5GB Free, Dropbox <a href="https://www.dropbox.com/en\_GB/basic">https://www.dropbox.com/en\_GB/basic</a>, Microsoft OneDrive and Media Fire <a href="https://www.mediafire.com/">https://www.mediafire.com/</a>, other cloud storage options are also available. Cloud storage can be used for password storage such as Last Pass which offers a free password vault for the many passwords we all use today, kept safely in one place. Systems do not recommend the use of memory sticks. They are fragile, are liable to be misplaced and can carry viruses.

All pupils at Mayfield will be given a Microsoft Office 365 account with 1TB of Microsoft One Drive Cloud Storage for the entire time they are at Mayfield School as well as five licensed copies of Microsoft Office Apps to use on their own devices. One Drive can be accessed from anywhere with internet connection. The stored data will be virus protected and backed up. Microsoft Teams and OneNote will be familiar to many pupils, a digital notebook for whole class use where teachers can share resources and mark work.

All devices used by pupils must have current virus protection installed. Sophos for Home is a free download https://home.sophos.com/en-us/register.aspx .

### **Laptop / Tablet recommended specifications:**

- Operating system windows or Mac OS
- Minimum i5 processor
   However, if the price difference to upgrade to an i7 processor is negligible, we would recommend the i7 processor for longevity
- A minimum of 4GB RAM
- SSD drive –'Solid State Drives' (beware of 'bargain offers' on devices because these will probably be HD drives which are to be avoided)
- A stylus write on laptop with key board. <u>10 Best Laptops with Stylus Pen in 2021 Laptops100</u>

### In addition you should consider the following:

- All devices must have an antivirus package loaded such as the Sophos home virus protection. The basic version is free to download <u>Sophos Home | Cybersecurity made simple</u>
- As light in weight as possible, with a large screen area
- A good protective sleeve or case
- Headphones
- Identifying everything (laptop, case, cable and charger) with a bright mark or name. A tangle of laptop chargers all look the same in a classroom! Fluorescent nail varnish is one way to mark property or Sharpie pens to help your daughter quickly identify her equipment
- Make a separate note of the serial number, make and model and make sure you register for any warranties and separate insurance
- If a tablet option is taken it would be good to invest in a keyboard and stylus pen.

Once their School email account has been activated in September, all pupils have access to five free Microsoft Office Licences to download onto their devices. In addition pupils will be sent a desktop shortcut to enable a remote session log in anywhere with internet. This service offers full access to a School desktop and files stored in pupils' personal folders.

### **Sports and Riding Uniform**

There are three periods of sport a week for Years 7 to 9 and all sports (including swimming) are compulsory to Year 9. Year 10 have three periods and Year 11 have two periods of sport a week, but they may choose their sports (i.e. they may choose NOT to do Swimming or Hockey etc.). Those pupils that make the 1st Team in any sport will be required to buy a 1st Team sweat top, skort and polo shirt (currently in navy and red) or a red swimming cap for Swimming 1st Team, in addition to their regular sports kit. The Equestrian Elite Team currently require a red Mayfield Equestrian base layer top, the Mayfield Silk and Numnah.

#### **Sixth Form Sport**

You will choose your sport option in the first week of term and should wait until then before you purchase any Sport Uniform that may be required from the School Shop. Riding is classed as a sport option. If you are picked for any of the School 1st Teams, additional uniform may be required (depending on the sport).
