Minutes

- Safety
 - Kaysville City completed a traffic study near the school. Josh Belnap reported a reduced speed zone and additional crossing guard were "not warranted". He reported the city is making a traffic safety video for all residents and will be placing signs on streets near the school to discourage parking during drop-off and pick-up hours before and after school. He also noted that a stoplight on 200 N. and Bonneville Lane has not been formally planned but a formal evaluation of that intersection had been planned
 - Principal Andrews met with UDOT officials this week. Work beginning April 19 will begin impacting the roads and area around the school. The school now has an official contact and UDOT will keep the school apprised when work is to be done around the school. Plans are for the work around 200 N. to be completed in 2023
 - The school and PTA are planning a safety campaign in the fall
