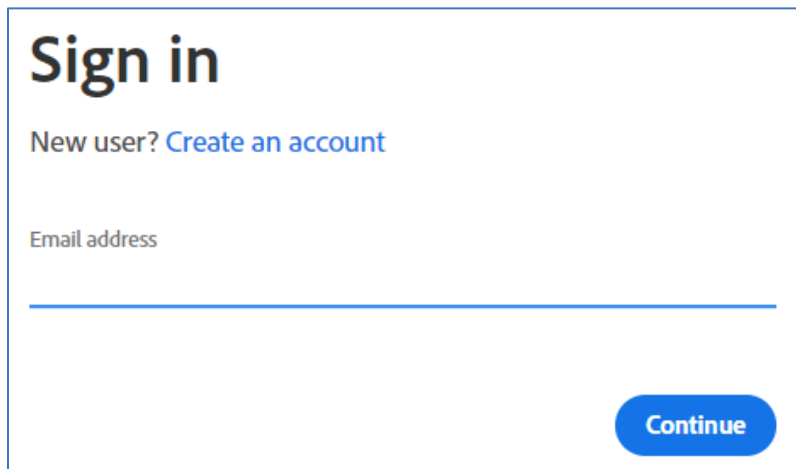


Adobe Creative Cloud: Installing Adobe Apps

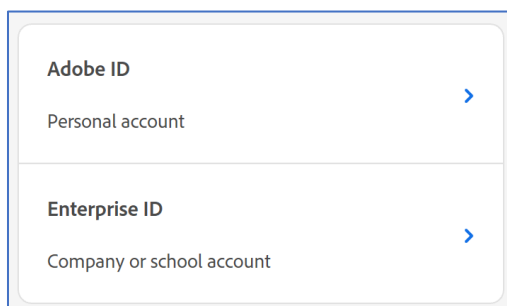
The following instructions apply for Davis School District Secondary Students. Elementary students do not have licenses for Adobe.

Please Note: The Adobe license allows each user to install the Adobe programs on 2 computers. If you try to install on a third computer, you will be prompted to deactivate one of the previously used licenses.

1. Go to <https://creativecloud.adobe.com>
2. Click on **Sign In**.
3. Type your district student email address then click on **Continue**. If prompted to enter your password, enter your student PIN#.
