## **COVID Reporting and Contact Tracing**

- Families must report positive case in their household to their teacher, principal or school nurse
- School leadership or nurse will follow up with the student/family for symptom and contact information
- Students or staff who may have been exposed will be contacted by the school

## **COVID Testing**

- COVID testing is available to staff, students and household members
- Diagnostic testing
- Screening testing
- Permission required for students to be tested

## **Isolation & Quarantine**

- If your child has contracted COVID or has been exposed please work with your school and/or health care provider to determine isolation and/or quarantine length
- In general, children who have contracted COVID can return to school after 10 days\*
- In general, children who have been exposed to COVID can return to school after 10 days

### **Attendance**

- If your child has symptoms or has been exposed to someone who has COVID, do not go to school in person.
- Contact your child's teacher to access remote learning
- Call the school office if your child will be absent from in-person or remote learning

### **Absences**

- For students attending in person, your child is absent if they are not physically present
- For students attending remotely, your child is absent if they
  do not log on to their online courses and/or complete
  assigned work (asynchronous) within a 24 hour period
- For students who may be on a temporary remote status (quarantine), the rules for remote-only students apply

## **Safety Measures**

- Vaccinations required for all staff
- Masks required for all staff and students
- Physical Distancing
  - To the extent possible, students maintain 3 feet distance (except while eating)
  - To the extent possible, adults maintain 6 feet distance
- Ventilation
  - Meets or exceeds requirements in all schools
- Cleaning and disinfection protocols

## **Transportation Plan**

- Masks are required
- Students are socially distanced to the extent possible on the bus. Students from the same household will be seated together whenever possible.
- All fans will be set to "outside air" and run constantly.
- Windows will be open for ventilation to the maximum feasible, depending on weather conditions.
- Roof vents will be open at all times





## **School Meals**

- 6 feet distance, to extent possible
- May use larger indoor or outdoor covered spaces
- No Cost meals for all students (federally funded)
