

Appendix F Third Credit of High School Level Mathematics

All students are to earn credit in Algebra I and Geometry. The content of the third credit of math may be chosen by the student based on the student's interest and their high school and beyond plan, with the agreement of the student's parent or guardian or, if the parent or guardian is unavailable or does not indicate a preference for a specific course, agreement of the school counselor or principal. If a student has chosen a four-year degree pathway, the student is advised to earn the third credit of math by taking Algebra 2 or Algebra 2 Honors. The school must in all cases give precedence to the direction of the parent(s) or guardian(s), if provided, in election of the third credit.
