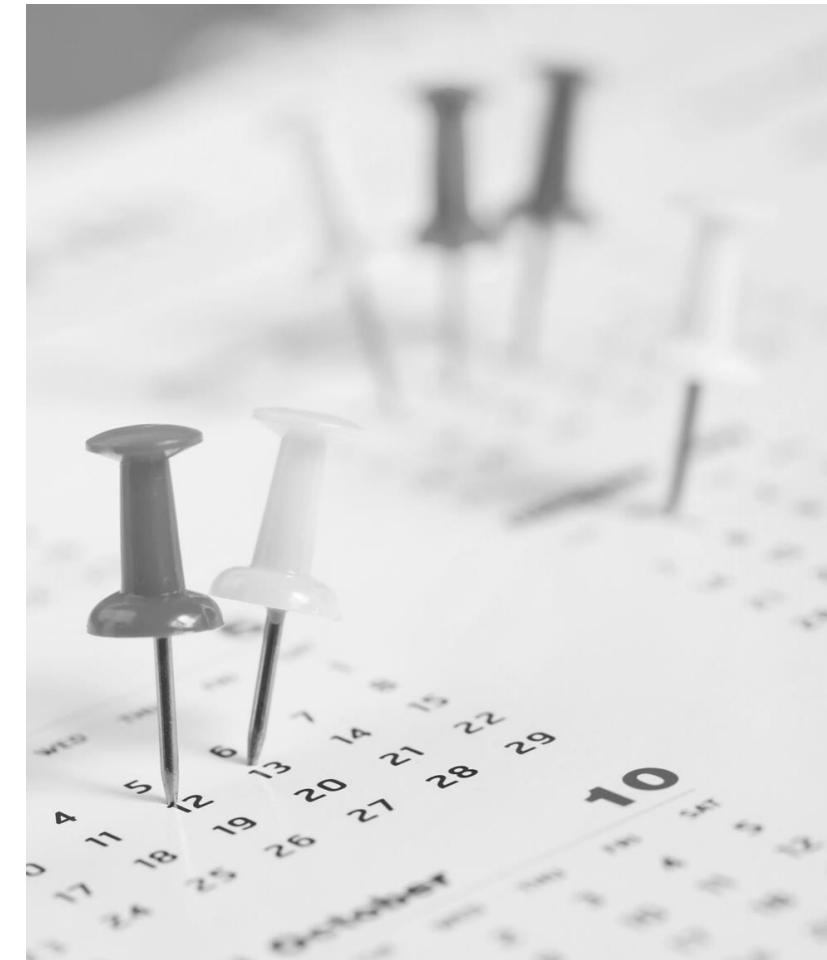

BACKGROUND

- Facilities work began in 2013 then again in 2016. With the community's input, it was determined that a phased approach was necessary to address the district's critical facilities needs.
- In April 2018, the community passed Prop B, a no-tax increase bond for new construction and renovation at BMS and BHS.
- In June 2020, the community passed Prop E, a modest tax increase to rebuild McGrath with space for Early Childhood and renovate Mark Twain.



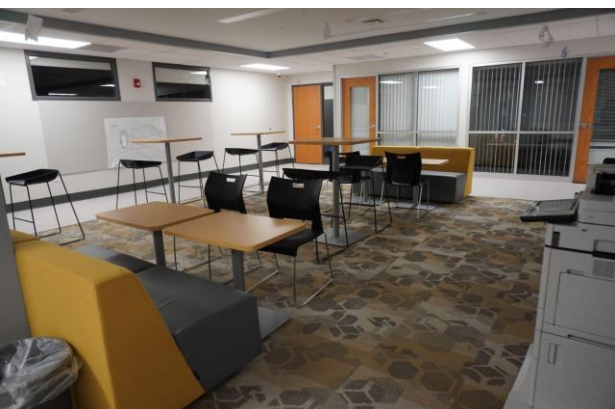
PHASE I - MIDDLE & HIGH SCHOOL

In April 2018, Brentwood School District residents overwhelmingly supported Prop B, a no-tax increase bond issue designed to bring important updates to the secondary schools in the district. In particular, Prop B focuses on the areas of:

- Safety & Security
- Accessibility
- Classroom Learning

Construction began in Fall 2019 and, with the exception of an elevator and a few minor details, construction of the Middle and High School has been completed!

PHASE II - ELEMENTARY & EARLY CHILDHOOD

In June 2020, the community passed Prop E, a modest tax increase to rebuild McGrath with space for Early Childhood and renovate Mark Twain.

In July 2020, the district established an Elementary Facilities Design Committee to provide feedback and guidance on the overall design of Prop E construction. Throughout the 2020-2021 school year, this committee met with staff and other stakeholders to discuss the process.

Early sitework at McGrath began on May 31, 2021 and was completed on August 23. Construction is currently set to be complete at McGrath in December 2022.

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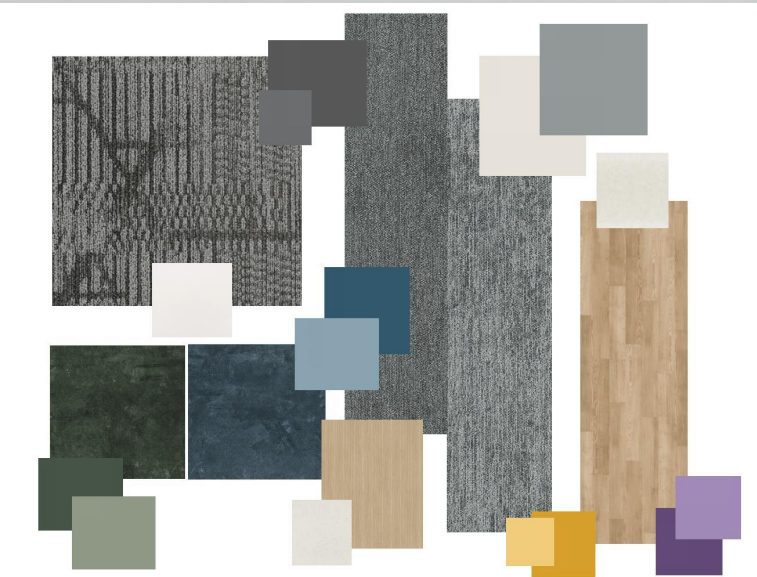

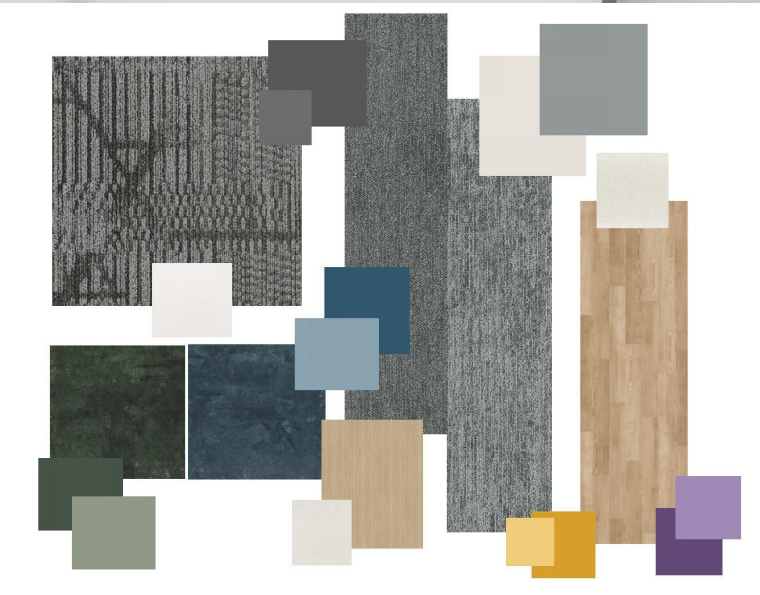

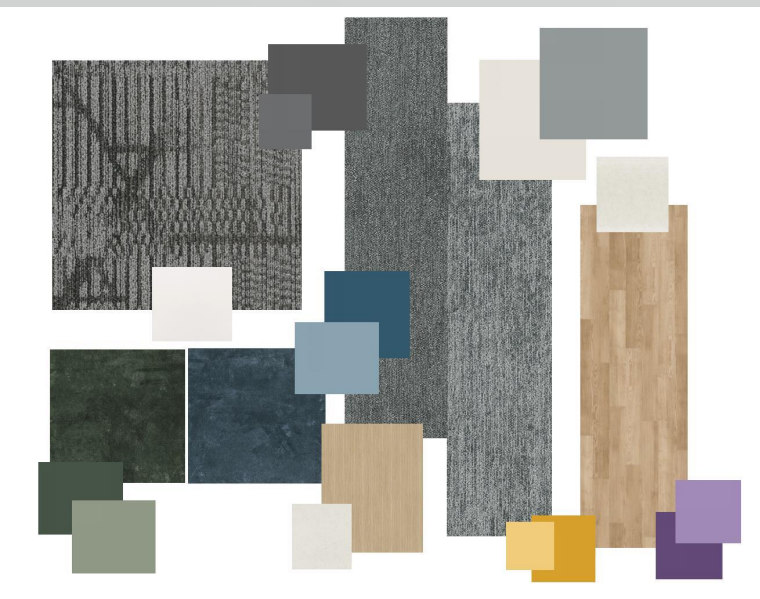

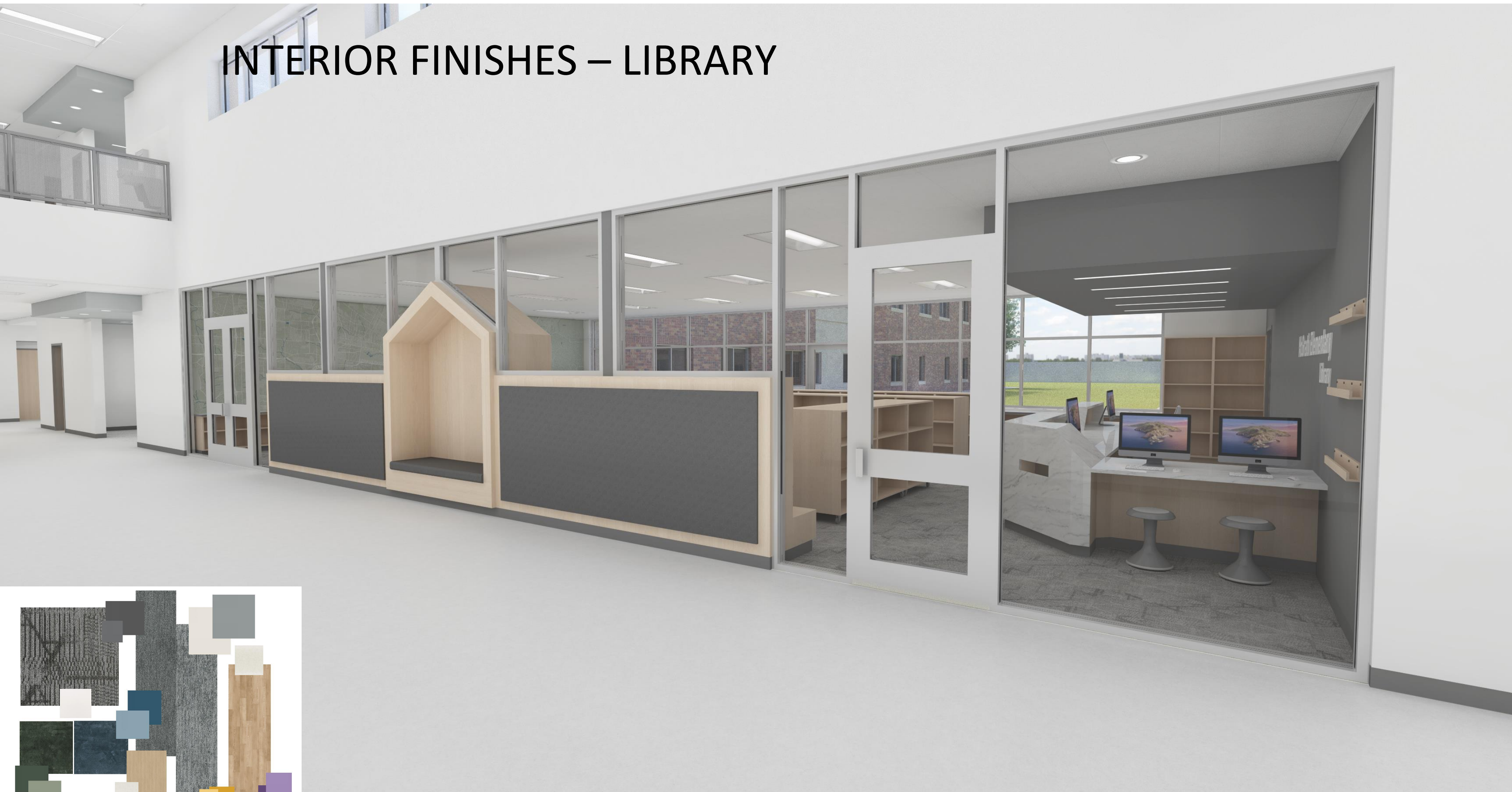

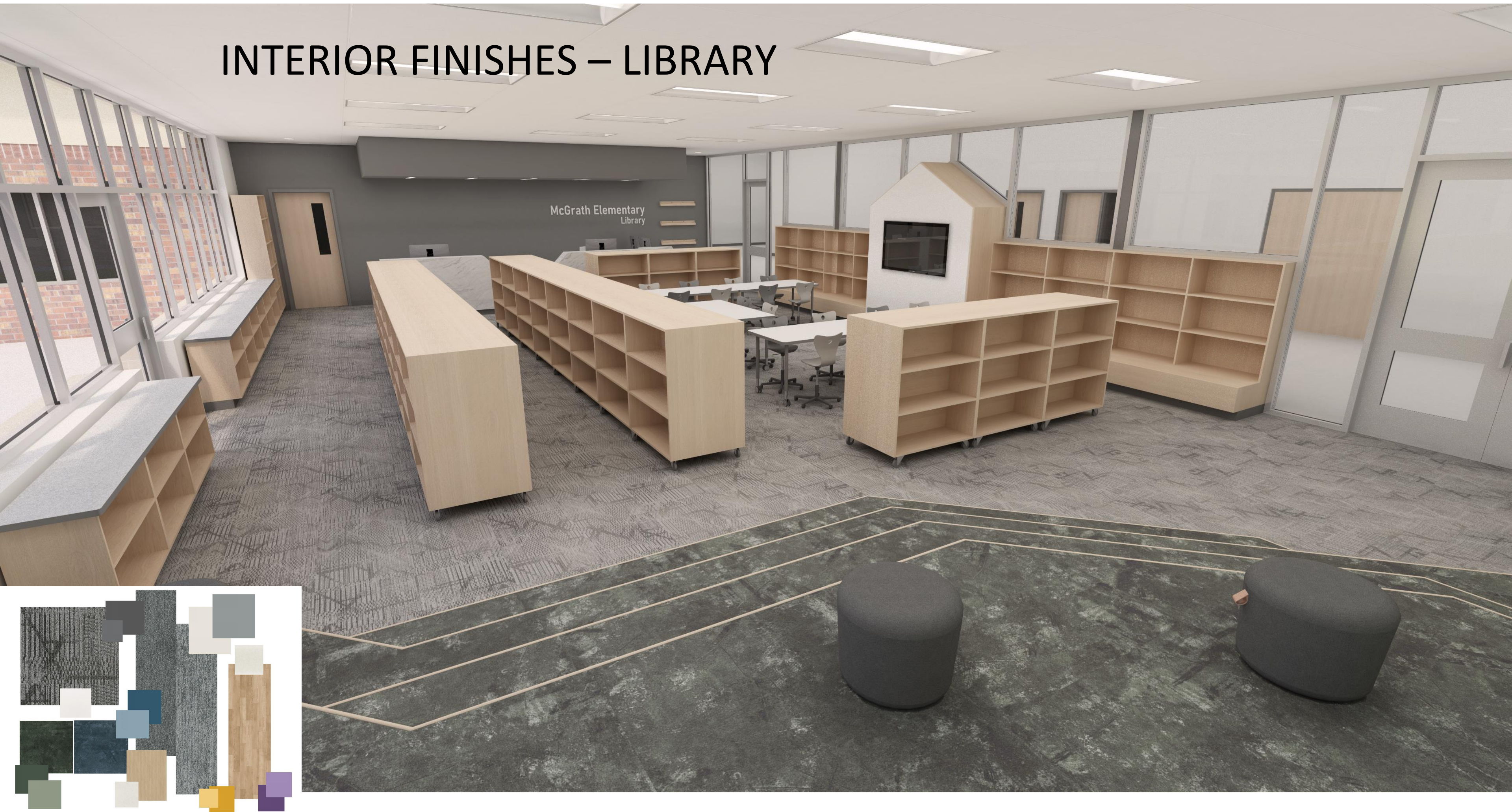

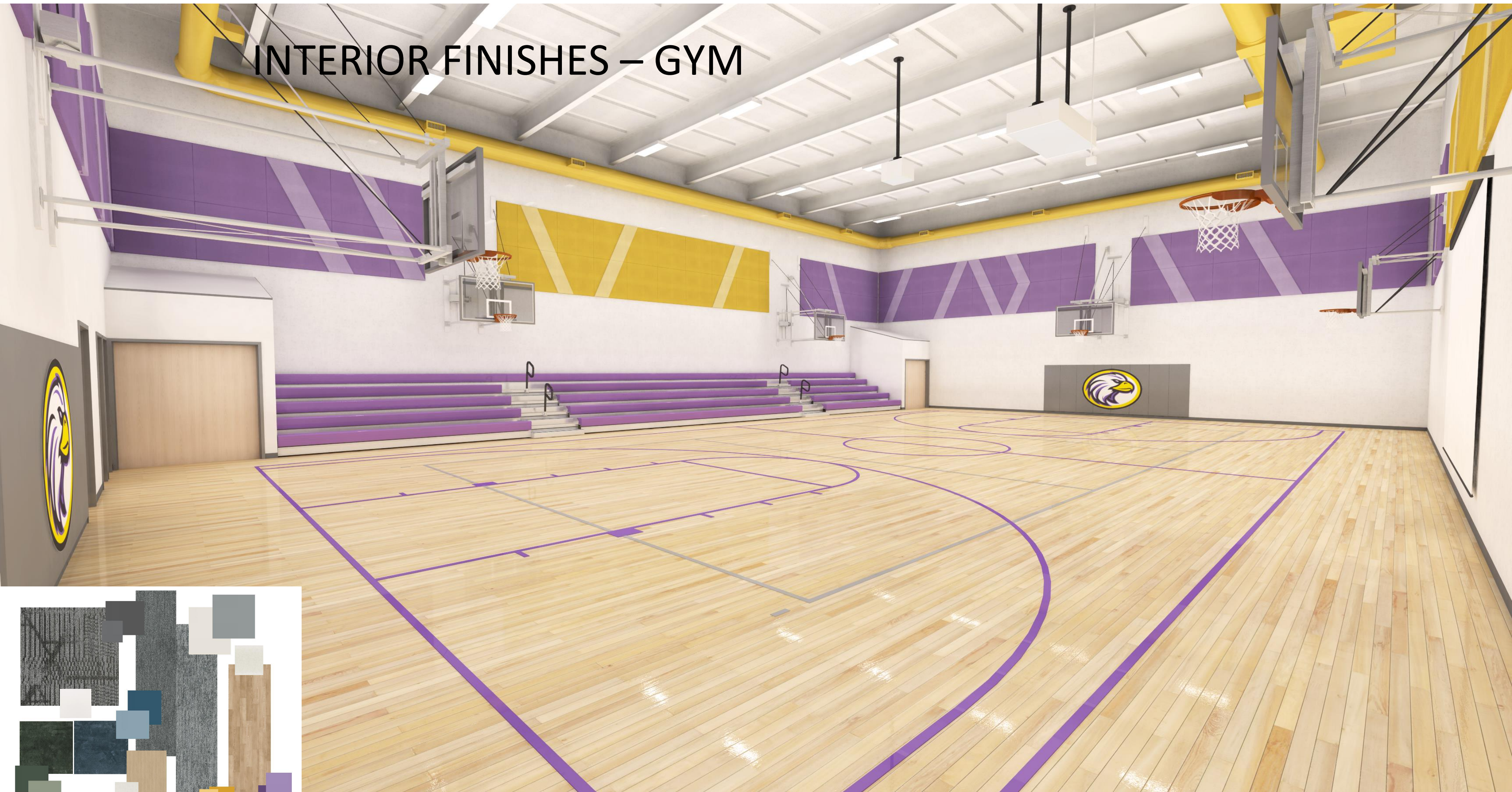
