In June of 2021, the Board of Education participated in the same surveys that the FMPC engaged in.

The following information displays the results of these activities with comparisons to the FMPC results.

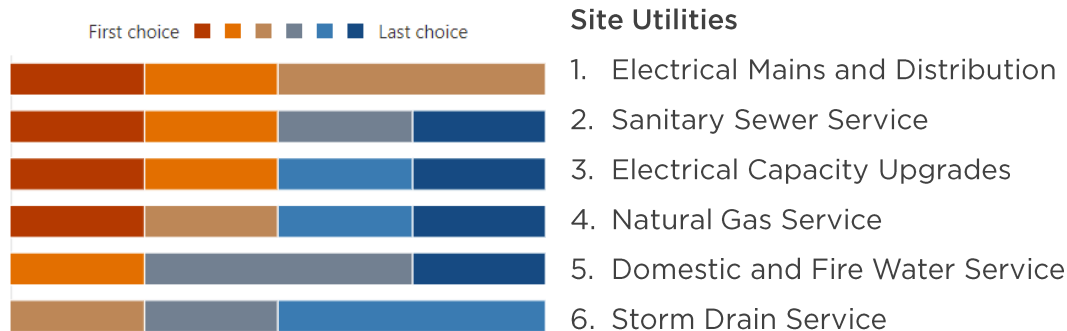
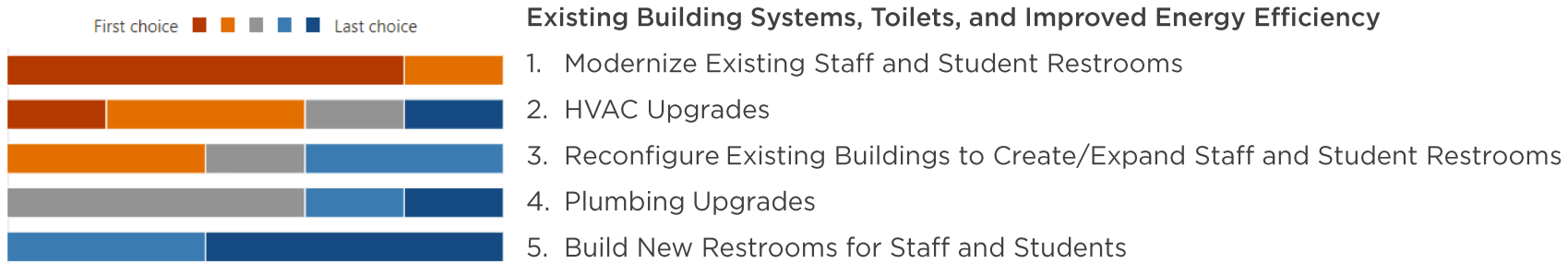
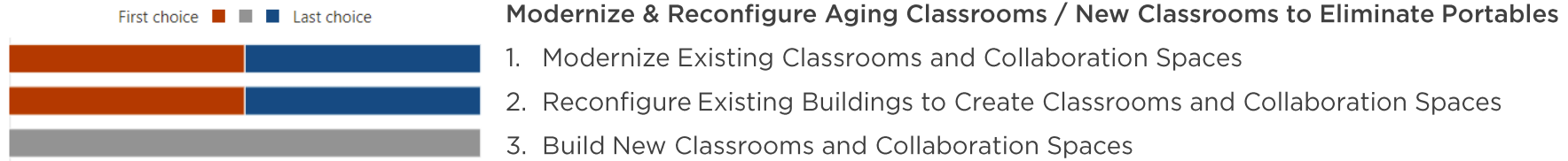

The Board of Education went through each scope of work category individually and ranked the sub-categories in order of priority. The following represents the results, based on 5 responses.

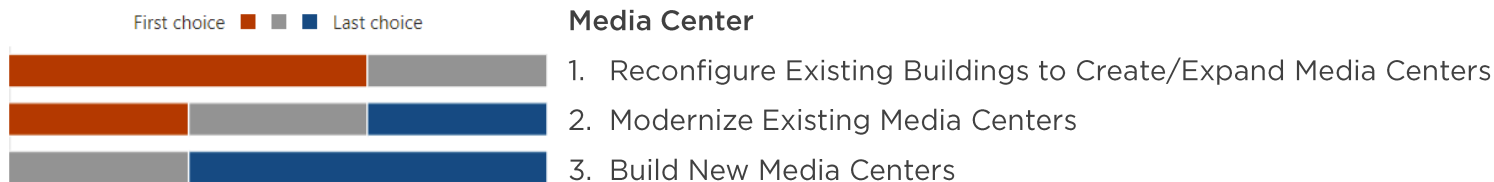
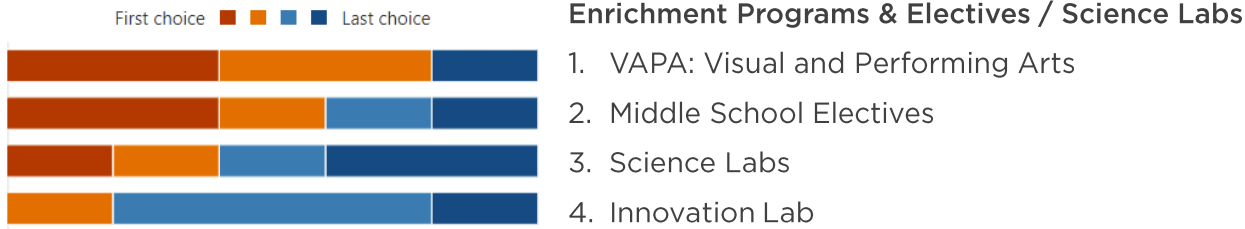


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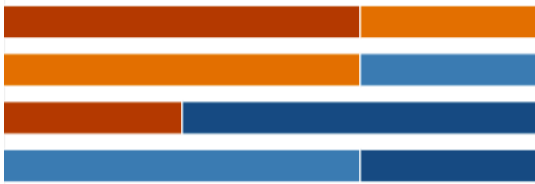

6. Infrastructure for a New, Site-Funded Marquee Sign

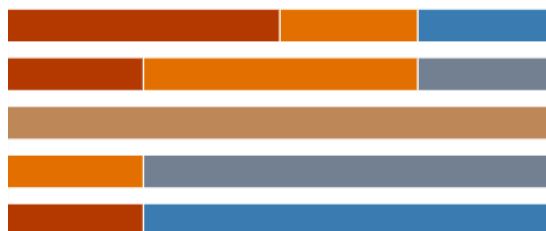
