Required Student Meetings

- Teachers will meet with students daily. Kindergarten through 3rd grade teachers will post meeting times on their Seesaw page each day. 4th and 5th grade teachers will post this on their Schoology page.
- Meetings can be the whole class but in our design process many of our teachers are creating small group and individual meetings as needed for different groups for students. There might be times when the groups change or the groups might stay the same.
- Attendance will be taken for each class session.

Teacher Availability & Office Hours

- Teacher Availability is defined as times when teachers are available to meet at the request of a student (or parent).
- Each teacher will post these times on the Seesaw/Schoology page.

General Status Update

- We currently have about 200 students K-5.
- Students will have synchronous/required meetings with their teachers daily
- Students will also have time in the day for asynchronous class work.
