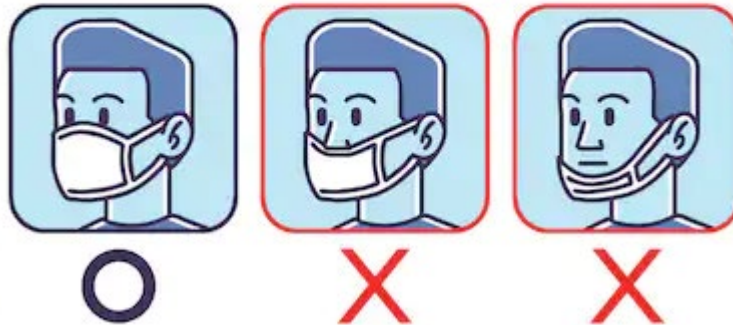


Mask Regulation

If the family refuses to comply, the student will be sent home immediately. <input type="checkbox"/> A re-entry meeting will be scheduled <input type="checkbox"/> If appropriate mask wearing is a continual issue other disciplinary measures will be utilized
