

What to Expect at School

Things will look different when students return to school. We are doing everything we can to keep students, families and staff safe while creating a positive learning environment.

BEFORE YOU LEAVE HOME Families *must* review an at-home self screener each morning to ensure absence of COVID-19 symptoms. Students should bring their own reusable water bottles for use throughout the day and are allowed to bring a bag lunch and snacks from home.

ON THE BUS Students will be required to wear masks while on the bus

ARRIVING AT SCHOOL Families who drop off their student to school are not currently permitted inside the school building and will hand off their student to the classroom teacher outside the building.

MASK ON Staff, students and visitors must wear face masks in the school building. Masks can be removed when eating and drinking at designated times and should maintain six feet of physical distance when possible. If a student forgets or loses his or her mask, a disposable one will be provided for the day. Students who may need an exemption must work with school personnel to determine if an accommodation is appropriate.

WASH UP Hand sanitizer stations will be available in every classroom along with soap and paper towels at classroom sinks. Teachers will require students to take breaks for hand-washing before and after eating and before sharing learning materials.


OUTSIDE Students 4K-8 are required to wear masks on the playground or when outdoors.

LUNCH Students will eat breakfast, lunch and snacks in their classroom at their desk/table when possible. School food service staff may deliver pre-packaged food items to each classroom. Students can bring a bag lunch from home, but must follow the same nut-free food item district guidelines.

RECESS Students must wash their hands before entry and upon exiting the playground. Students 4K-8 are required to wear masks on the playground or when outdoors.

RESTROOMS Students will be given verbal directions and see visual signage posted in the restrooms to remind them to keep physical distance. Students must wash their hands before returning to their classroom.
