DTE SCHOLARSHIPS FOR 2025

Up to eight Art, Drama and Design, Technology and Engineering (DTE) scholarships are offered for award in 2025 to candidates of suitable quality.

Candidates for DTE Scholarships will be invited to Tonbridge in the week beginning 20th January 2025 for interview and a practical assessment. Prior to the scholarship day candidates will be sent a design task and an evidence of work form. These completed documents should be brought along on the scholarship assessment day. It is hoped the design task will provide candidates with an opportunity to demonstrate their creative problem-solving ability, their analytical skills, their technical knowledge, and their communication skills. In addition, the evidence of work form (consisting of space for a maximum of 6 images) will enable them to showcase the best practical/project work they have completed. This could be work completed at school during curriculum time, outside lessons during clubs/activities or at home. These images should be photographs of physical work or screenshots of digital work. Please note, practical work should not be brought to interview. The design task and evidence of work form should be either submitted digitally to richard.day@tonbridgeschool.org (by Monday 20th January) or as a hard copy and brought with the candidate to the assessment day.

On the assessment day, there will be an interview of approximately 15 minutes. In addition, candidates will complete a timed assignment which will cover all areas of the design process. This task will allow them an opportunity to demonstrate their individual ability in design and technology.

Remission Amount

DTE scholars will be awarded a prize of £2,000, which will be deducted from the first term's fees. The award of a scholarship may additionally provide fee remission of any amount up to the full school fee, if assessment of the parents' means indicates a need.

Age Limit

Candidates for DTE Awards must be under 14.0 on 1st September 2025.

Multiple Awards

A DTE Award may be held in in conjunction with any other scholarship awards at Tonbridge.

Key Dates

- The application form of an intending candidate must reach the Admissions Office by 1st December 2024.
- Assessments will take place in the week beginning 20th January.
- The design task and the evidence of work form will be sent to candidates in the week beginning 6th January. (Digital submissions must be received by 20th January and hard copies brought along to the assessment day.)
