DTE SCHOLARSHIPS FOR 2022

Up to eight Art, Drama and Design, Technology and Engineering (DTE) scholarships are offered for award in 2021 to candidates of suitable quality.

Candidates for DTE Scholarships will be invited to Tonbridge in the week beginning 24th January 2022 for interview and a practical assessment. A portfolio of the candidate's work should be sent to the school no later than one week before the assessment day. This portfolio should be produced by the candidate and should take the form of a written and photographic record which outlines a snapshot of the best work carried out in Design & Technology, Electronics, ICT or a combination of all three.

It is hoped that this portfolio will showcase a candidate's skillset and include work that has been completed in addition to the normal curriculum. It is hoped that the portfolio would include a range of skills including sketching and graphical communication, technical knowledge and understanding, ICT and/or Computed Aided Design and photographic evidence of 3D models and practical outcomes. Please note, practical work should not be brought to interview, but good pictorial evidence should be in the portfolio. The portfolio can either be submitted in an electronic format (PowerPoint / Website) or as a physical hardcopy.

On the assessment day, there will be an interview of approximately 15 minutes. In addition, candidates will complete a design and a practical assignment, covering all areas of the design process, hence allowing them an opportunity to demonstrate their individual ability in design and technology.

Remission Amount

DTE scholars will be awarded a prize of £2,000, which will be deducted from the first term's fees. The award of a scholarship may additionally provide fee remission of any amount up to the full school fee, if assessment of the parents' means indicates a need.

Age Limit

Candidates for DTE Awards must be under 14.0 on 1st September 2022.

Multiple Awards

A DTE Award may be held in conjunction with any other scholarship awards at Tonbridge.

Key Dates

- The application form of an intending candidate must reach the Admissions Office by 1st December 2021.
- Examinations will take place in the week beginning 24th January.
