
2021-2022 TEST RESULT DECISION TREE

Isolation and Quarantine Recommendations While Awaiting and After Receiving COVID-19 Test Results



^{*} If a student or staff person (who is <u>not</u> a close contact) has any COVID-like symptoms that are common to a variety of illnesses, <u>the person should get tested</u>. Student/staff may return to campus <u>if</u> 24 hours after fever resolves, symptoms improve, and a negative test result is given to the school.

A doctor's note can only be used in place of a negative test to return to school if:

- a. the symptoms experienced are identical to those of a documented underlying chronic condition (e.g., asthma or diabetes); or
- b. the healthcare provider determined, through medical evaluation of the person, that there is an *alternative*, *named diagnosis* (e.g., streptococcal pharyngitis or coxsackievirus) that explains the symptoms experienced.
