Welcome to what is going to be an amazing 2021/2022 school year at Centerville Elementary! We have been going strong for a little over a week and have started to get into our routines. We have started on a positive note and I am confident that this year will be better than last year. I look forward to the activities and lessons we have planned.

We at Centerville Elementary, make safe schools a priority. One of the ways we do this is through Safety drills: i.e. Fire, Lockdown, Lockout, Evacuation, Shelter in Place, and Re-unification drills. Over the past few weeks we have been working on our Safety Plan, part of which involves participation in these drills. We will be holding one of the above drills about once a month. This helps everyone to become conditioned to what to do in event of an actual emergency.

Next week is our food drive held to support the 9/11 National Day of Service. In remembrance of the day 20 years ago that made 9/11 infamous, we are collecting food to make pantry packs for Davis School District children in need. All donated food items (which are listed in the article below) can be dropped off in the bins near the school office between September 7 – 10. Students throughout the district use these pantry packs to assure they do not go hungry over the weekends and all donations are greatly appreciated.

I have truly been excited to start the school year with these and other changes. With your help we can accomplish many great and important things as the year progresses! Please know that we appreciate your support as we move forward into the school year.

How are we addressing Covid this year?:

The following protocols are in place to help us through this time of uncertainty and help prevent infection from illness at school. As we embrace in-person learning this year, there are some important protocols to keep in mind.

- Covid-19 Big 5 safety precautions will remain a priority in our daily happenings. This includes daily disinfecting of surfaces and handwashing measures.
- We continue to work with Davis County Health Department with Covid-19 positivity cases.
- All absences should be reported to our front office. We highly encourage you to report Covid-cases contracted by your student or within the household. Our Covid-aide may contact you about reported cases and/or to verify information as needed. Please know that all of us at Centerville Elementary will keep your information confidential as we honor HIPPA guidelines.

- Regarding Covid-19 communications from our school, please understand that any email or letters you receive from us pertain only to Covid-19 within Centerville Elementary and not from our community.
- We continue to request that anyone who exhibit symptoms of an illness will stay home and get better before returning to school. Teachers will work with students who are sick and give them an opportunity to make up work that was missed when they were out.

Arrival:

The morning bell rings at 8:45 and students will be tardy if they arrive after the tardy bell at 8:50. Students who eat school breakfast may arrive as early as 8:15 and enter through the front of the school. Those who do not eat school breakfast should not arrive before 8:30 when we have playground supervision. Students should plan to be on the back playground as they wait for the first bell to ring in the mornings. Late students should enter the front of the school and check in at the front office.

Dismissal

Students will exit the building at the end of the day on the East side of the school facing our back playground. Those waiting for siblings should plan to have a meeting place outside. All drivers waiting for students are asked to park along the curbside on the exterior of our school/playground areas and avoid using the parking lots unless you are exiting your vehicle.

Parking to enter the school is easiest done on the West side of the school, where you have easy access to the front doors. All doors are locked for the safety of our students. To gain access to the building you will need to bring your ID and ring the doorbell at the main doors – on the West side of the building - to interact with the office management.

Pantry Pack Food Drive in conjunction with the National Day of Service:

September 11, 2001 was a dark day in the history of our country, but we came together as a country...united and strong. Twenty years later, we are coming together again in unity, love, and strength as we work together in this great 9/11 National Day of Service.

- Individual microwavable meals, 7-8 oz (Mac and Cheese, Spaghetti and Meatballs, Chef Boyardee cans or cups, Chicken & Rice, Cup of Noodles, Ramen)
- Applesauce cups or fruit cups
- Pudding cups (shelf stable)
- Individual oatmeal packets
- Peanut butter crackers or cheese & crackers (individual size)
- 1 gallon Ziploc freezer bags
