



The Colorado State Board of Education and the Englewood Schools Board of Education formally adopted a menu of college and career-ready demonstrations that students must use to show what they know or can do in order to graduate from high school, beginning with the graduating class of 2021. Students must demonstrate college or career readiness in English and math based on at least one measure.

One of the menu options is scoring a '2' or higher on a district-approved AP exam. Below is a table outlining the initial list of Englewood approved AP exams for demonstrating college or career readiness in English and math. This list was crafted using information collected from peer districts, consultation from the district Assistant Superintendent, and input and thinking from the Englewood Learning Services team, administrators and teachers.
