NUEVA Wechsler Intelligence Scales (WPPSI-IV, WISC-V) **Guidelines for Submission**

All Nueva applicants for grades PreK-8 are required to take a Wechsler IQ test. The testing results need to be submitted to Nueva directly from the psychologist after they have received permission to do so via the signed Authorization for Release of Confidential Information form completed by the parent or guardian. The following guidelines are for families who make an appointment for IQ testing with a psychologist off-campus. Please review them carefully, and then share them with the psychologist you have chosen.

For Families and Psychologists

Nueva accepts the results of the WPPSI-IV or WISC-V. Applicants must be 3 years 10 months or older for the WPPSI-IV. Applicants who are 6 years of age and older must take the WISC-V.

Off-campus results for grades 1 to 8 are due **January** 14, 2022. Off-campus results for PreK and K are due January 28, 2022.

NOTE: The Nueva application is due Thursday, January 6, 2022.

If test results have been provided for two consecutive admissions seasons, the applicant will need to take the evaluation again.

Any licensed psychologist who is experienced in administering the Wechsler Scales to children can administer the evaluation. Please check **Ravenna** and our website: www. nuevaschool.org/admissions/ iq-faq for referrals.

Prior exposure to test materials and/or use of practice questions invalidate results. Please be aware your child should not study for the evaluation.

The Wechsler Scales are designed to capture current cognitive abilities.

Applicants may only take the Wechsler Scales once in 12 months.

The Wechsler Scales should NOT be given in-person in a child's home. An office or school setting is required.

Virtual and outdoor administration is allowed.

The psychologist needs your signed permission to release the results to Nueva, which can be done via email or mail. The Authorization for Release form is on page 2.

After the psychologist has submitted the Wechsler results and narrative report to our office, we will follow up with you regarding next steps in the application process.

For Psychologists

The following subtests are required for our application process for the WPPSI-IV and the WISC-V:

- WPPSI-IV: Block Design, Information, Matrix Reasoning, Bug Search, Picture Memory, Similarities, Picture Concepts, and Cancellation.
- WISC-V: Block Design, Similarities, Matrix Reasoning, Digit Span, Coding, Vocabulary, Figure Weights, Visual Puzzles, Picture Span, Symbol Search, and Arithmetic.

We require all Index Scales and a Full Scale IQ (FSIQ) to be reported.

A narrative report with behavioral observations must accompany the scores. For this admissions season,

we especially appreciate any insights that might help us better understand the Nueva applicant.
