QUICK FACTS

- All-male, college-preparatory Catholic private school founded in 1871 in the tradition of the De La Salle Christian Brothers, serving 718 students in grades 9 through 12, with 198 students in the senior class.
- Lasallian Core Principles: Faith in the Presence of God, Quality Education, Concern for the Poor and Social Justice, Respective for All Persons, and Inclusive Community
- Network of 11,000+ alumni across the country and abroad
- 12:1 student-faculty ratio; Average class size of 19
- For the 2020-2021 school year, approximately 35% of families received financial aid totaling \$2.1 million.
- Average ACT Score for Top 10% of Class of 2021: 33; Average ACT Score for Class of 2021: 26
- The 190 members of the Class of 2021 were accepted to 172 unique colleges and universities across 30 states. They attended 50 institutions and earned a combined \$21 million in merit-based scholarships.
- In the past 4 years, 10 students were named National Merit finalists with 14 students commended for their performance.
- Nine students have scored perfect ACT scores in the past five years.

Since 2012, CBHS has implemented a 1:1 technology model, ensuring every student has a laptop for his entire academic career. In 2020, CBHS implemented a hybrid-learning model following the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic. Since Spring of 2021, CBHS students have resumed attending class in-person full-time.

GRADING & RANKING

- Christian Brothers does not rank students.
- Transcripts only include courses and grades completed at Christian Brothers High School. If a student enters CBHS with high school credits, a transcript from his previous school will be provided.
- GPA is calculated solely using courses completed at Christian Brothers High School.
- Honors and dual-enrollment courses are weighted one quality point. AP courses and Advanced Calculus III are weighted two quality points.

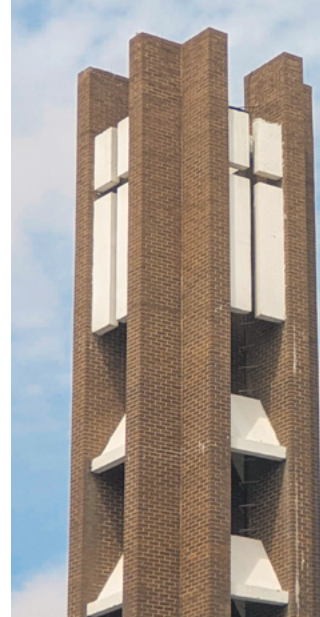

Students in the program participate in diverse extracurricular activities to develop their Lasallian charisma and are enrolled in the most rigorous courses offered at Christian Brothers High School.

CBHS offers a four-year comprehensive STEM program with three distinct tracts: engineering, biomedical science, and computer science. The STEM Co-Lab culminates with Engineering & Development, a capstone experience that enables students to address and solve real-world problems.
