TO ALL 6th FORM PUPILS AND PARENTS

As you may know, the School has a Sixth Form Club, the purpose of which is to provide a social centre and entertainment for the pupils. The Club is run by a committee of representatives from each house, the Steward, Mrs Whittle, and the Staff Chairs, Miss Bradley and Mr Fulling.

Various events and parties are arranged during the year. Whilst the vast majority of these are free, the larger ones, like the annual Valentine's Ball, do charge an entrance fee. The cost of such tickets will usually go on the School bill, unless a parent/guardian requests otherwise. To finance the other events, and to purchase items for use in the club, an annual membership fee is charged of £10 for boarders and £5 for day pupils.

The club tuck shop is open every break time, while the tuck shop and bar are open three nights a week. Since the introduction of the 2003 Licensing Laws, no pupil can purchase alcohol; but the School continues in its efforts to train 6th Form for the future as outlined on the accompanying document.

In order to join the Club, to use its facilities, to take part in the various events and to be served any alcohol, a pupil must provide a completed application form confirming that they agree to abide by the Club rules and that they understand and agree that behaviour appropriate to a school campus will be observed at all times. Parents/guardians are also required to sign in order to approve the membership application. This process is completed when a pupil joins the Sixth Form and the membership lasts for two years.
