Reminders for our Juniors: Recommendation Letters, Essay-Writing, and our Summer Workshop!

Earlier in April, juniors were instructed to approach one teacher for a letter of recommendation to be included in college applications. As of now, students who need a second letter of recommendation are welcome to ask. Please see Haiku (on the Twelfth Grade page) for a list of colleges requiring more than one teacher recommendation. Once the teacher has agreed to write the letter of recommendation, the College Counselors will do **all** follow-up to ensure its completion before the first application deadline.



After our in-person AP Exams, the college counselors will spend two days (either Monday and Tuesday *or* Thursday and Friday) with each junior-level English class to begin the discussion around the main college essay and supplemental questions. We expect to see every junior in these sessions throughout the week of **May 24 – 28**, and we are excited for the Class of 2022 to begin thinking about the meaningful and creative ways they can express themselves through writing. Unlike other portions of the admissions process, writing is something our students have *full* control over; it's a time and space for students to share their voices.

Finally, this summer, College Counseling will host its most important sessions for the Class of 2022. Throughout the month of August, current juniors will attend a one-on-one scheduled appointment with one of our college counselors or attend a small group workshop on **August 23 – 25** to better understand Bullis School's college application process, complete the bulk of their Common Application, and navigate some back-end technology work to allow for seamless document submission.

Recognizing our Senior Student-Athletes

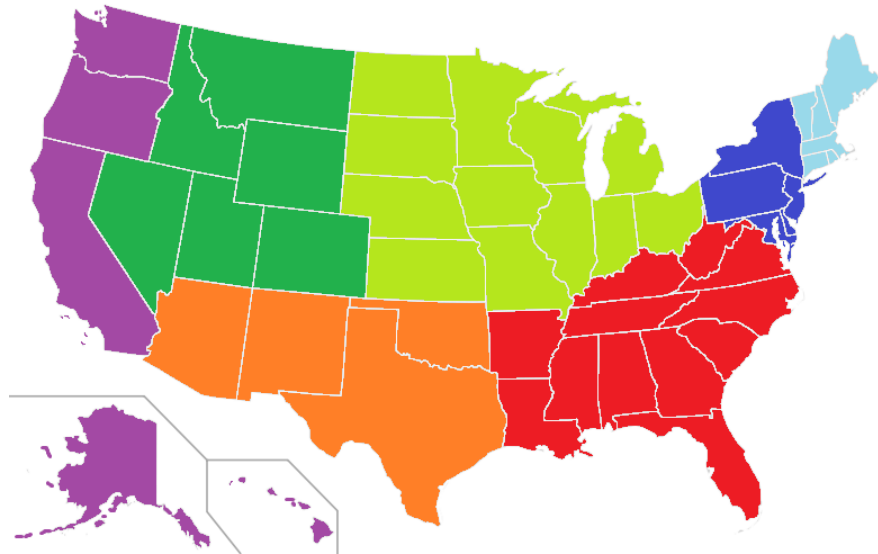
