Position Summary: The contact tracer will provide assistance with contacting and educating students and employees who need to isolate or quarantine due to COVID or an exposure to COVID. This is a full-time, non-exempt, temporary staff position.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Notify students/employees if they are identified as a close contact to someone who tested positive for COVID
- Explain quarantine/isolation guidelines to affected individuals
- Communicate with quarantined/isolated students daily to assess for needs
- Promptly notify Health Center staff of any changes in the status of quarantined/isolated patients
- Communicate with faculty to obtain seating charts to assist with contact tracing
- Document finding in the patient's electronic medical record
- Collaborate with a diverse community of constituents in all aspects of work

Qualifications and Experience:

- High school graduate; 2+ years of related work experience required
- Medical background or working knowledge of COVID preferred such as CMA, LPN, or RN
- Strong communication skills and the ability to work in a fast-paced, high-energy environment
- Working knowledge of Google Workspace and MS Office
- Experience in collecting and maintaining data preferred
- Customer service experience preferred
