MIDDLE AND HIGH SCHOOL

The mission of the Student Academic Support (SAS) program is to provide students with the opportunity to maximize their learning abilities in order to reach their full academic potential.

FCS is a rigorous college preparatory school. The Student Academic Support (SAS) program can accommodate students with mild learning challenges.

Each student is evaluated through the admissions process to determine the level of support needed to be academically successful within the FCS program. The level of support is determined by the Student Academic Support team based on the documentation provided.

FCS is not equipped to provide support for behavior challenges, significant accommodations or any modification that fundamentally alters the college preparatory program.

Standardized and Finals Testing Accommodations

Students are provided testing accommodations for standardized testing and finals.

Classroom Accommodations

Students are provided testing & classroom accommodations within the regular classroom setting.

Learning Lab Class:
10 Student Maximum

Students are provided testing and classroom accommodations in the regular classroom. This class provides general guidance with executive functioning skills. SAS does not provide academic tutoring.

LEVEL 4

Learning Lab Small Group:
6 Student Maximum

Students are provided testing, classroom and small group accommodations in a regular classroom. The small group class provides a structured environment for more individual guidance with executive functioning. SAS does not provide academic tutoring.

Accommodations Available:

(based on eligibility documentation & recommendation of Student Academic Support Team)

- Extended time on assessments & standardized testing per Eligibility Report (not to exceed 50%)
- Small Group Testing Environment for final exams
- Preferential Seating in classroom & for final exams
- Mark answers in test booklet; no scantron
- Mark answers in large print test book (standardized testing only)
- Use of 4 function calculator in non-calculator sections (standardized testing only)
- Provide both auditory and visual directions
- Encourage self-advocacy skills
- Encourage use of graphic organizers for writing assignments, note taking and review
- Use a calendar or agenda
- Allow use of technology for a specific purpose
- No penalty for misspelled words unless specific to the assignment and student has been informed
- Lecture notes, visual presentations or outlines can be provided to the student. Classroom teachers have the discretion in the type of note support provided. Note support is meant to be a supplement, not to replace active, independent note taking.
