Today you will be continuing to explore the moon with as many members of your household as possible.

### 6. Journey to the centre

Journey to the centre of the moon to see what alien objects you can find (balls or rolled socks). Discuss what you find e.g. eggs or rocks.

### 7. Pick up your alien egg or rock

All take an alien egg or rock (ball or pair of socks). Explore the egg or rock by squeezing it and bouncing it, but be careful!

#### 8. Eggs alive!

When you or another astronaut shouts "Eggs alive!" they start to wobble and move in your hands and take you around the moon as you move in and out of each other and around the moon.

#### 9. Swap eggs

When the captain shouts "Swap eggs!" look up and find another astronaut to swap with.

#### 10. Change eggs

When the captain again shouts, "Change eggs!" place your egg on a moon spot, move around the surface and pick up a different egg.

# 11. Play with your egg

With a partner, explore different ways of moving your egg around your body, for example, round the waist/through the legs. Don't drop it!

### 12. Return to the space ship

Return to the space ship with your egg and prepare to blast off home to earth.

Continue your exploration of space. Where will you travel to next? How will you move when you get there?
