National Professional Qualifications from September 2021

From September 2021, reformed National Professional Qualifications (NPQs) will offer teachers and leaders clearer development opportunities and career progression.

These qualifications will build on key areas of the Early Career Framework (ECF), allowing for further specialisation and development of expertise and help prepare teachers and leaders the next step in their careers.

The reformed qualifications aim to:

- Help teachers hone and develop the skills they already have, helping them to become more effective leaders inside and outside the classroom and improving overall teaching quality;
- Retain high-calibre teachers in the profession by offering clearer development opportunities and career progression.

How are the NPQs being reformed?

To best address the broad range of responsibilities of current and aspiring middle leaders, the Middle Leadership NPQ has been replaced with three new specialist NPQs.

These specialist qualifications are:

- National Professional Qualification for Leading Teaching (NPQLT);
- National Professional Qualification for Leading Behaviour and Culture (NPQLBC);
- National Professional Qualification for Leading Teacher Development (NPQLTD).

The reformed suite of leadership NPQs includes:

- National Professional Qualification for Senior Leadership (NPQSL);
- National Professional Qualification for Headship (NPQH);
- National Professional Qualification for Executive Leadership (NPQEL).



NPQ for Leading Teaching (NPQLT)

Completion of this qualification leads to the National Professional Qualification for Leading Teaching.

Cohorts of NPQLT commence in both the autumn and spring terms each academic year and we invite applicants from international schools worldwide.

Who should consider NPQLT?

NPQLT is for teachers with at least 3 years teaching experience. NPQLT is suitable for teachers who have, or are aspiring to have, responsibilities for leading teaching in a subject, year group, key stage or phase.

Leading teaching is complex. Although the role varies, many phase leaders, key stage leaders, heads of department (or similar titles) are considered to be part of the middle leadership team. They often directly manage a team of teachers and their work is focussed on supporting effective teaching across the school.

Applicants for NPQLT must be able to evidence that they have a level 5 or higher qualification, support and commitment from their school and financial support (if applicable).

NPQ for Leading Behaviour and Culture (NPQLBC)

Completion of this qualification leads to the National Professional Qualification for Leading Behaviour and Culture.

Cohorts of NPQLBC commence in both the autumn and spring terms each academic year and we invite applicants from international schools worldwide.

Who should consider NPQLBC?

NPQLBC is for teachers with at least 3 years teaching experience. NPQLBC is for teachers who have, or are aspiring to have, responsibilities for leading behaviour and/or supporting pupil wellbeing in their school.

Leading behaviour and culture is complex and professionals looking to lead in this area need to have expertise across a number of specialist areas related to their role (e.g. behaviour systems) and in approaches that, through working with their colleagues, enable their school to keep improving (e.g. professional development and implementation).

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Who should consider NPQLTD?

NPQLTD is for teachers with at least 3 years teaching experience. NPQLTD is for teachers who have, or are aspiring to have, responsibilities for leading the development of other teachers in their school.

They may have responsibilities for the development of all teachers across a school or specifically trainees or teachers who are early in their career. This programme is ideal for NQT/ECT Mentors and Induction Tutors.

What are the eligibility criteria?

Applicants for NPQLTD must be able to evidence that they have a level 5 or higher qualification, support and commitment from their school and financial support (if applicable).

NPQ for Senior Leadership (NPQSL)

Completion of this qualification leads to the National Professional Qualification for Senior Leadership.

Cohorts of NPQSL commence in both the autumn and spring terms each academic year and we invite applicants from international schools worldwide.

Who should consider NPQSL?

NPQSL is suitable for senior leaders with cross-school responsibilities, for example, an experienced middle leader, a deputy head, a special educational needs co-ordinator (SENCO), an advanced skills teacher or a senior member of staff.

Although the role varies, many senior leaders contribute to all aspects of the school through the leadership team as well as having a specific whole school responsibility of their own. This means the role is often both operational and strategic and relies on working with and through colleagues (in particular, through middle leaders) to ensure every pupil gets an excellent education.

NPQ for Headship (NPQH)

Completion of this qualification leads to the National Professional Qualification in Headship.

Who should consider NPQH?

NPQH is suitable for those who have recently been made headteachers or who are highly motivated to become headteachers, **and no more than 18 months from applying for headship**.

Key changes to NPQH from September 2021:

- Reduced programme fees to support schools recover from the impact of COVID-19;

- Assessed school-improvement projects have been replaced with practice-based formative and summative assessment tasks;
- Greater focus on practice-based activity and participant context

Applicants for NPQH must be able to evidence that they have a level 5 or higher qualification, support and commitment from their school and financial support (if applicable).

NPQ for Executive Leadership (NPQEL)

Completion of this qualification leads to the National Professional Qualification in Executive Leadership.

Cohorts of NPQEL commence in both the autumn and spring terms each academic year and we invite applicants from international schools worldwide.

Who should consider NPQEL?

NPQEL is suitable for colleagues aspiring to, or already in, leadership roles across more than one school. This includes headteachers, executive headteachers and directors of school improvement.

Applicants must be a serving headteacher (or equivalent role) with a minimum of 3 years' leadership experience.

Overseeing multiple schools with different cultures, priorities and challenges requires a different set of leadership skills than those required of a Headteacher. Accessing peer support, specialised knowledge and experience from other sectors, as well as the support and challenge of executive coaching, can make the transition much easier.
