

## HOMWORK REQUIREMENTS 2021-2022

In the Northern Ireland Revised Curriculum, taught in Forms 1-3 in the College, there is a strong emphasis on pupils taking responsibility for their own learning. This independent learning should involve each pupil reinforcing what has been done in class or doing their own research to enhance understanding. Parents should be aware that in all subjects, homeworks may on occasion be extended over several nights. Please check the homework diary regularly. Details of Winter Assessments will follow later in September.

### FORM 3

<b>ART AND DESIGN</b>	<b>No more than 1 per fortnight x 1 hour.</b> Literacy task 20% of marks in Winter report and 10% of marks in Summer term.
<b>BIOLOGY</b>	<b>2 per fortnight x 20mins each.</b> There will be a formal homework or project which will be used for continuous assessment and will be included in examination results. The project could take at least 2 homework slots in a topic.
<b>CHEMISTRY</b>	<b>2 per fortnight x 20mins each.</b> There will be a formal homework or project and an end of topic test for each booklet which will be used for continuous assessment and can be included in examination results. The project could take at least 2 homework slots in a topic.
<b>ENGLISH</b>	<b>4 per fortnight x 30mins each.</b> Homework tasks may take the form of preparation, practice, extension or creative activities. Homework will be assessed through a mixture of marks out of 20, teacher comment, self and peer assessment and oral feedback.
<b>FOOD &amp; NUTRITION</b>	<b>1 per fortnight x 30mins.</b>
<b>FRENCH/GERMAN SPANISH/RUSSIAN</b>	<b>4 per fortnight x 20mins each.</b> These will be a combination of reading, writing and learning homeworks. One of the learning homeworks will normally be tested (either formally or informally) on a weekly basis.
<b>GEOGRAPHY</b>	<b>2 per fortnight x 20mins each.</b>
<b>HISTORY</b>	<b>2 per fortnight x 30mins each.</b> Homeworks take a variety of forms such as creative work (posters), revision for tests, research of specific topics and extended and empathetic writing etc.
<b>LATIN</b>	<b>4 per fortnight x 20mins each.</b> Vocabulary test marks will count for 10% of the Winter assessment process and vocabulary test marks will count for 10% of the Summer Examination.
<b>MATHEMATICS</b>	<b>4 per fortnight x 20mins each.</b> Homeworks will consist of formally assessed work at the end of each topic, exercises continued from class, online exercises and the learning of topics towards class tests.
<b>MUSIC</b>	<b>2 per fortnight x 20-30mins each.</b>
<b>PHYSICS</b>	<b>2 per fortnight x 20-30mins each.</b> This will include some formal homework or project and an end of topic test for each booklet. These will be used for continuous assessment and included in the Summer Examination assessment. Projects could take at least 2 homework slots in a topic.
<b>RELIGIOUS EDUCATION</b>	<b>1 per fortnight x 30mins.</b> Homework will include revision for class tests and research projects which will take at least 2 homework sessions.
<b>TECHNOLOGY</b>	<b>1 per fortnight x 50-60mins.</b> A4 design sheets will be set each term; these will count towards the Winter and Summer grades. Additional homeworks will be set at the individual teacher's discretion.
