RABUN COUNTY SCHOOLS COVID-19 PREVENTION STRATEGIES FOR 2021-2022

Safety

- Students and staff may wear masks while on campus.
- Students and staff will be encouraged to wear masks while on the school bus.
- Students with any signs or symptoms will be directed to the school nurse where appropriate procedures will follow including contacting parents/guardians.
- All students and staff who are sick are required to stay home.

School Logistics

- Large group gatherings and field trips will be limited as needed.
- Pick up and drop off procedures will be limited as needed.
- The number of people in the school cafeteria and on the playground will be limited as needed.
- Students will only be able to ride the bus to their designated stops.
- Visitor procedures have been updated and are available on our website.

Enhanced Cleaning

- Approved disinfectant and hand sanitizer will be available throughout the building.
- Frequently touched surfaces within the school and on buses will be cleaned and disinfected often.
- Enhanced cleaning will occur throughout the school building, playground, and school buses.
- Regular applications of Ecovasive electrostatic EPA registered botancil disinfectant will occur.
- Contactless water bottle filling stations are available throughout the schools. Students are encouraged to bring their own water bottled from home.

Wellness

- School employees will teach and reinforce healthy hygiene practices.
- Staff and students will be encouraged to use social distancing as needed.
- Temperature screenings may occur.
- Signage will be posted throughout our buildings with precautionary measures and reminders.
- Additional school counselors are available to address the social and emotional wellness of our students.
- Students must be fever free for 24 hours before returning to school.
- Families should notify the Board of Education if anyone in the home tests positive.
- If an employee or student has a confirmed case of COVID-19, the system will follow the Georgia Dept. of Health's guidelines for returning to work/school safely.
