

School Checklist

Schools With a Religious Affiliation

- Research Schools
- Attend Open Houses in the Fall
- Request accommodations and sign up for the HSPT (High School Placement Test)
- Schedule a school interview (if applicable)
- Request a mock interview

- Complete and submit application by the due date
- Submit up-to-date neuropsychological testing directly to the school
- Attend accepted student revisit days
- Notify school of your decision

Independent Schools

- Research Schools
- Attend Open Houses in the Fall
- Request accommodations and sign up for the SSAT (if applicable)
- Share SSAT scores with Secondary School Advising and submit SSAT scores to schools
- Schedule a school interview and tour
- Request a mock interview
- Complete and submit application by the due date
- Submit up-to-date neuropsychological testing directly to the school
- Attend accepted student revisit days
- Notify school of your decision

Public Schools

- Contact your school district and inform them of your intention to have your child return to public
- Register your child with the school district
- Acquaint yourself with the Special Education departments in the High School and Middle School (you will be working with both)
- Sign a consent to test through your district and provide any new neuropsychological testing (if applicable)
- Allow the town to complete testing (if applicable)
- Schedule an IEP meeting
- Inform Placement Office of the scheduled IEP meeting
- Attend IEP meeting
- Request a student shadow day
- Sign IEP

Vocational, Technical, Agricultural Schools (VTA)

- Register your child with the school district
- Determine if your town is within the "District" of your chosen VTA
- Review the admissions policies including those for out-of-district students (if applicable)
- Attend Open Houses in the fall
- Complete and submit application by due date
- Forward record requests to the Carroll School Placement Office
- Schedule a mock interview
- Interview at the school (if applicable)
- VTA schools are considered public and therefore you should follow the Public Schools checklist in order to create an appropriate IEP
