But just in case, use this checklist to stay on track.*

- Review your **transcript**. Make sure you are on track with credits and your diploma type requirements. Speak to your counselor if you have questions.
- Keep your **grades** up!
- Utilize **NAVIANCE**: Research/compare colleges, sign-up for college rep visits,
- Take the **SAT/ACT** this fall if you haven't already. Many colleges will not require a test score, but you may need a test score for scholarship and specific programs within the university.
- Focus on your **Post-Secondary Plans**: Where do you hope to be a year from now: College? Military? Apprenticeship? Check out **IndianaCareerReady.com** for career/work related resources)
- Apply to college early**, when possible. Be sure to turn in a blue form for each college.
- Make a list of deadlines and be aware of special activities and events for seniors. Check the **ALC Guidance Fall Calendar**.
- Plan a **Campus Visit**. You are allowed two during the senior year. Pick-up the **College Visit Form** in the ALC Guidance Office.
- Visit with **College Reps** during one of our 7 mini-college fairs this fall! Register on Naviance.
- 21st Century Scholars**: Complete your requirements. Log in to your Scholar Track account to complete the Scholar Success Program. **ScholarTrack.in.gov**
- Complete the **FAFSA!** It opens October 1 and the Indiana deadline is April 15, 2022.
- Continue with your **in-school and community activities**. Scholarship committees will want to see your best effort through graduation.
- Visit a local **College Fair**.
 - The *National College Fair* is September 10 at the Indianapolis Convention Center.
 - The *Hendricks County Apprenticeship & Trades Fair* is September 22 at Avon High School.
 - The *Indianapolis (West) Christian College Fair* is September 29 at Covenant Christian HS.
