STUDENT DRIVER AND PARKING REGULATIONS: Because of real and potential problems associated with the use of student vehicles, the following procedures must be followed when parking and/or driving on school grounds.

1. Driving a vehicle to and from school is necessary and requested by a parent through the completion and signing of this registration form.
2. Vehicles must be in good repair and covered by adequate liability insurance by the company listed above. **A copy of your driver's license and current insurance card must accompany this form.**
3. Vehicles must be parked on campus in accordance with directives listed in the student handbook, the LHS Parking Regulations Notice and the daily bulletin. Consequences for parking violations will be progressive in nature (fines, loss of parking privileges for the year, Friday School and possible suspension from school). Vehicles may be booted or towed, both at the owner's expense.
4. Vehicles, when driven to school, are for transportation and are not to be driven or otherwise used during school hours without the school's permission. **Sitting, smoking and/or eating in vehicles is specifically prohibited.**
5. The speed limit on campus is 10 mph.
6. Parking permit must be in place in the lower left hand corner of the windshield, visible from outside the vehicle.

As the parent, my signature below indicates that I hereby request that my son/daughter be granted permission to park a vehicle on campus. I give him/her permission to use this vehicle for a job, school program or off-campus for lunch.

I have read and understand the student handbook section on parking, the Lindbergh Parking Regulations Notice, and the statements on top of this page. I also realize that my vehicle **MAY BE BOOTED OR TOWED AT THE OWNER'S EXPENSE** (as deemed necessary by the school) and that I could receive parking fines, etc. if I am parking without a permit or illegally parked. Vehicles parked on school campus are subject to search by school personnel.

REGISTRATION AND REGULATIONS

Students must pay the parking fee (\$ [REDACTED] = \$ [REDACTED] and submit a Student Vehicle Registration, complete with signatures, copy of driver's license and copy of current vehicle insurance card, prior to issuing the permit.

SCHOOL PARKING REGULATIONS: Driving to school is a privilege. The rules of the road apply to campus driving and the speed limit is 10 miles per hour. During the school day, student drivers are restricted from using the lower circle during the hours of 6:30 am – 3:30 pm.

Student parking is limited to the upper lot, south of the gym by the pool. There is absolutely no student parking in the visitor or staff areas.

Vehicles must be parked within the designated lines in one stall and a sticker must be visible in the lower left hand corner of the windshield.

Loitering in parked vehicles or in any of the parking lots is prohibited during the school day. The parking lot is off-limits unless the student is leaving for a job, education program or lunch.

Starting the second week of school, parking violation notices will be issues to students who are in violation of parking regulations.

A vehicle may be booted or towed, at owner's expense, if parked without a valid permit or illegally parked in one of the following: fire lanes, staff parking, visitor parking, handicapped parking, loading zones and undesignated areas. Students are to be aware of handicapped areas which are designated by painted pavement or signs.
