1	Do the three stockpile sites currently have leaves stockpiled? What are the addresses of each of the three sites?	<p>At present, there are leaves stockpiled at the Nye Street site.</p> <p>The three site locations are as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Firehouse - 25 Nye Street- Legion Field - 65 Regan Road- Church Street site is located at the intersection of Church Street and Washington Street.
2	Are Payment and Performance Bonds required?	Payment and Performance bonds are negotiable as part of contract negotiation.
3	<p>There was no mention of liquidated damages in the bid packet; however, I'm being asked by our bonding company to confirm that the liquidated damages are reasonable, if any, and a term of twelve months or less.</p> <p>Will you please clarify if there are any liquidated damages, and what the term is?</p>	Liquidated damages are negotiable as part of contract negotiation. The term of liquidated damages will be twelve months or less.
