



LA PORTE ISD COVID-19 STUDENT DAILY SCREENER

Parents are required to conduct the Student Daily Screener with their student **EACH day** prior to arriving on campus or boarding a school bus. Parents must ensure they do not send a child to school if the child has COVID-19 symptoms, is awaiting COVID-19 test results or is test-confirmed positive with COVID-19. **If you are unable to check your child’s temperature at home, please call the campus front office so a designated staff member can check your child’s temperature when your child arrives onsite.** This daily screener will be completed at home each day.

		<p>*For the purposes of prolonged exposure, consider close contact with individuals at home: (a) being directly exposed to infectious secretions (e.g., being coughed on while not wearing a mask); or (b) being within 6 feet for a cumulative duration of 15 minutes, while not wearing a mask. If vaccinated (12 and older only), please refer to the Student Process Map for additional guidance.</p>

If the student or parent answered yes to any of the above:

- The student must remain off campus until cleared to return; contact the campus nurse.
- If test-confirmed for COVID-19, the parent must follow up with the **campus nurse** before student can return to campus.
- If symptoms develop after student arrives on campus: Campus will isolate the student and notify a parent to pick up the student within 30 minutes.

LPISD will follow the Student Process Map for COVID-19; it is also recommended that you consult with your health care provider.

Reminders to follow if you are cleared to return:

- Masks are strongly encouraged, but not required.
- Wash your hands or use hand sanitizer regularly.
- Practice social distancing of at least 3 feet and comply with all campus COVID-19 protocols.

The information collected from this screening form is confidential. If a student has been test-confirmed for COVID-19, the campus nurse and La Porte ISD must be notified, as required protocols must be timely followed, including notification to designated entities and appropriate staff and parents.
