### *Create*

- **Playwriting:** Use correct form and structure to create a scene or play with a beginning, middle, and end that includes full character development, believable dialogue, and logical plot outcomes.
- **Characterization:** Explore and sustain physical, vocal, and emotional choices to develop a performance that is believable, authentic, and relevant to a drama/theatre work.

### *Perform*

- **Rehearsal Etiquette/Ensemble:** Perform as a productive and responsible member of an acting ensemble in both rehearsal and performance situations.
- **Perform:** Memorize and present a drama/theatre work using creative processes that shape the production for a specific audience.

### *Respond*

- **Justify or defend responses** based on personal experiences when participating in or observing a drama/theatre work.
- **Describe, analyze, and compare** artistic choices developed from personal experiences in multiple drama/theatre works.

### *Connect*

- **Theater History:** Examine historical and contemporary social, cultural, or global issues through different forms of drama/theatre work.
