## Music Theory

- Classify and analyze foundations of music literacy including but not limited to notation, decoding rhythm/melody, transcription, improvisation, and composition.

## Instrument Skills

- Demonstrates musical artistry and correct playing technique including but not limited to posture, bow hold, bowing ability, finger agility, and tone production.

## Aural/Listening Skills

- Demonstrate aural sensitivity to pitch, blend, and balance in musical passages, scales & finger patterns, and general tuning.

## Perform

- Demonstrate transference of music theory skills, rehearsal habit skills, instrument skills, aural skills, and response skills in a performance setting such as but not limited to, school concerts, festivals, and recitals.

## Rehearsal Skills and Habits

- In Class/Group Rehearsal Skills and Habits: Demonstrate productive rehearsal habits including but not limited to classroom behavior, preparedness, respect for room/materials/instruments, and supporting fellow musicians.
- Personal Rehearsal Skills and Habits: Develop a personal practice routine that includes, but not limited to goal setting, building musical skills/concepts and self-assessment/reflection.

## Connect and Reflect

- Demonstrate understanding of music intent and expression from the perspective of the culture, composer and/or music time-period through listening, analyzing, and performing. Demonstrate recognition of individual interpretation of music and how music relates to personal development and enjoyment of life.
