# From the Office of the President

COVID continues to present consistent challenges. Last year our first positive case was in October. This year it was on our second day of full in-person instruction. The numbers for incidence per 100,000 and positivity rate continue to rise at rates comparable to last fall.

As we are located within the City of Philadelphia, we are strictly required to follow the guidance provided by the City of Philadelphia Department of Health. The Pandemic Team here at Nazareth submits a City of Philadelphia Department of Health survey daily to report any exposures to COVID, along with reporting any positive cases. When we report a positive case, we must provide a list of close contacts.

Designations of who is considered a close contact are not made by Nazareth, nor is Nazareth setting the duration of quarantine or isolation periods.

These policies have been set by the City of Philadelphia, and to that end I have been working with the city's liaison in the COVID contact tracing department. On Wednesday, we received approval to consider close contacts unvaccinated individuals who sit in front of, behind or next to the positive case. Based on this discussion with a city official we are duty-bound to consider this our policy going forward.

It goes without saying that the pandemic has been an unprecedented event that has been exasperated by 24/7 media coverage since March 13, 2020. As restrictions and mandates fluctuate (sometimes wildly), we are all tasked with the frustration of toggling between being prudent citizens and resuming our traditional lives. We at Nazareth understand this frustration and do not wish to add to it.

Therefore, let me clearly convey that our goal is to follow the guidance above to ensure there is no risk of closure due to non-compliance of the city's mandates and recommendations. All while remaining full in-person and making every student, faculty and staff member feel safe.

For your convenience, please find the current <u>school guidance</u> which our Pandemic Team keeps updated with real-time changes along with the <u>Quarantine Visual Aid</u> from the City of Philadelphia Department of Health which should be helpful in understanding how the quarantine/isolation protocol is presently defined.

Thank you for your support and patience as we navigate what is hopefully the last few months of the challenges of the pandemic.

# From the Office of the Principal

This past week reinforced the unpredictability of both the pandemic and the weather. I hope that you are yours are safe and well. We pray for all those who are suffering as a result of Hurricane Ida.

The Counseling Activities postponed on Thursday due to the weather-related closure of school have been rescheduled for Tuesday, September 7<sup>th</sup>, now a Special C-Schedule. In most weather closures, such as snow, we will shift to a Flexible Instructional Day, where teachers assign students work or meet remotely for the class to account for time not being present in school. In the case of severe weather, such as Wednesday night and Thursday, when dangerous conditions potentially cause loss of life, injury, along with widespread property damage and loss of power, we will do what we did on Thursday, close school and cancel classes as the safety and well-being of our students, families, and staff is paramount.

# **Back to School Night**

We have discussed lessons learned during the pandemic and how we can do things differently, even as we work to emerge from the continued challenges of a public health crisis. Last year, when we are unable to hold events in person, we held each Back to School Night, both in September and January, remotely, through Microsoft Teams. After both nights, teachers shared that parent attendance increased from previous years. When we talked to parents, they cited the convenience of not having to rush to school and the ability to attend from the comfort of their own homes. Mindful of those positives, Back to School Night on Thursday, September 9<sup>th</sup>, will be held remotely, via Microsoft Teams.

We are excited to be holding in person events again this school, as evident early on with New Student Welcome Night, Mother-Daughter Mass and Breakfast, and the NAPA General Meeting, along a whole calendar of opportunities for parents to be in school in person. However, there is also great value in increased engagement, time saved, and added convenience for this Thursday's remote event.

Your daughters will share with you their school Teams account to access your class on Thursday night. Please follow your daughter's roster for Friday. In advance of Thursday night's event, an email of reminders will be sent to all parents.

Please encourage your students to read their emails and check for updates to the Class of 2022 College/Post-Secondary Information Microsoft Team. We update students as often as possible about colleges, scholarships, college visits with Nazareth, fee waivers, etc.

The senior class presentation will be rescheduled for some time next week.

There will be a senior parent presentation night on September 14<sup>th</sup> at 6:30PM. More information will be provided about this event soon.

### SAT School Day Class of 2022

If your student wants to take the SAT during our SAT School Day on October 13th, please have them fill out this SAT Sign Up Form by September 10th.

The cost is \$55, and you will be provided with a payment form before the SAT. If you believe your family may qualify for an SAT fee waiver, please follow this

link to see Eligibility Requirements. If you do meet the requirements, please contact me at amikulski@nazarethacademyhs.org so I can ensure you are billed appropriately. If your student has signed up and they would like to opt out, they have until September 14th to email me with that request.

# **Transcript Request Form Class of 2022**

When your student applies to a college or university, they need to request that their transcript be sent to that particular school. This should be done through the Transcript Request Form. There is a \$3 fee per transcript that is sent. (Example: If your student applies to 5 colleges, then the fee is \$15.)

### Instant Decision Days Class of 2022

Nazareth will be hosting an Instant Decision Day with Holy Family University on October 7<sup>th</sup>. Students who participate will be given an admission decision this day. Students should register by October 1<sup>st</sup> and complete an application to Holy Family University by October 4<sup>th</sup>. If your student is interested in registering, please have them fill out this FORM.

Nazareth will be hosting an Instant Decision Day with La Salle University on October 12<sup>th</sup>. Students who participate will be given an admission decision this day. Students should register for this event and complete an application to La Salle University by October 7<sup>th</sup>. If your student is interested in registering, please have them fill out this FORM.

### **Interview Day Class of 2022**

Nazareth will be hosting an Interview Day with Saint Joseph's University on October 26<sup>th</sup>. Students who participate will not be given an admission decision, but they can speak with the admissions representative about their application to Saint Joseph's University, about the university, or about anything else they would like to discuss related to admissions. It is preferred if students apply to Saint

Joseph's University before October 26th, but it is not required. Students should register for this event by October 21<sup>st</sup> by filling out this <u>FORM</u>.
