

Accessing a STONYHURST education

For eligible families, the Forces' Continuity of Education Allowance (CEA) can help towards the costs of boarding school. The allowance is available for children who start school the year which they turn 8 years old up to when they turn 18/19 years old. Please note that you must claim before your child reaches Year 12, as new awards are not given to Years 12 and 13.

Additionally, Stonyhurst offers military families a generous top up bursary for anyone in receipt of the CEA allowance.

The below table outlines the fee structure applicable to families based on their level of CEA allowance for all year groups.
