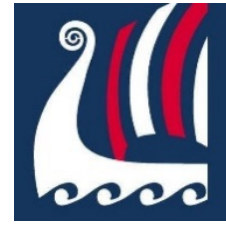

AP Exam Information 2021-2022



Dear Lynbrook Students and Families,

Welcome to the 2021-22 school year! As you are settling into your classes, we want to bring to your attention some important approaching deadlines and crucial information related to Advanced Placement (AP) exams. **If you plan to sit for any AP exams this year, then please read this entire document carefully and save it for your reference.**

This year, registration for AP exams will be from **September 13-October 1 (4:00pm)**. This registration window is mandated by the College Board® for all AP programs, and is not the decision of FUHSD. AP exams will take place from May 2-13, 2022. The exam fee is \$115 for regular format exams and \$125 for special format (World Language, Music Theory, Studio Art) exams. There will be no late registration, so students will need to plan carefully. If a student qualifies for financial assistance then the cost for each exam will be \$10 for regular format exams and \$15 for special format exams.

Note: The payment process is separate from registering online with a College Board join code. Both processes must be completed for every AP exam you wish to take.

We realize this registration timeline is very early in the school year, so we encourage students to talk over their exam decisions with their family, teachers, and trusted adults. Students should consider their confidence in the course content, overall workload, post-secondary plans, and their other commitments in the spring when deciding whether or not to take an AP exam. Some colleges and universities require that students taking AP courses take the corresponding exam. If you have successfully completed a community college class, you should NOT take the corresponding AP exam (see your counselor for clarification).

At this point in time, we are planning for all in-person testing without having the option of digital testing. In signing up for an AP exam for May 2022, you should be prepared to take the exam in whichever format, digital or paper-pencil, depending on county/state safety requirements and College Board/FUHSD offerings in May.

At Lynbrook, we will be offering two methods of payment for AP exams:

Online Purchases: FUHSD offers online registration for all exams through the [Infinite Campus Portal](#).

- Log into the Infinite Campus Portal
- Click on "school store", then "shop", "view" under the exam you want to purchase, select quantity of "1", "add to cart"
- Continue to complete the transaction by adding payment information for credit card or eCheck
- Complete payment and print receipt.

In Person Purchases: If you prefer to pay in person (check or cash) contact Ms. Boehm in the ASB office during brunch or lunch.

Restricted Purchase Exams: Some exams that have specific eligibility requirements (e.g. Chinese, Computer Science Principles, or late exams) are available for purchase through a structured purchase schedule. Please view [this document](#) regarding restricted purchase exams for more information.

Low Demand Exams: There are some exams that are considered “low demand” exams. Please read the “[low demand test details](#)” prior to signing up for these exams. Once an exam is confirmed that there is enough interest then your school site will notify you to register for the exam in IC.

Self-Study Exams: Students have the option to self-study for an exam and not take the corresponding AP class. This is also referred to as “Exam Only”. **To sign up for a self-study exam, complete payment for all subjects you want to take, and then you will receive an email containing your join code to sign up on CollegeBoard.org.** This email will not be sent automatically, so please be patient as we process requests.

Important Registration Dates for AP exams:

- **September 13:** FUHSD AP exam registration opens at 8:00am through [Infinite Campus portal](#) (payment by credit card or e-check) or in-person with Ms. Boehm in the ASB office.
- **September 27 - October 1:** FUHSD lottery sign up for remaining AP Chinese seats.
- **October 1:** FUHSD AP exam registration closes at 4:00pm online (check with ASB office for hours). **No late registration** after this time/date, neither in-person nor online.

2) How can I register for the AP Chinese Language & Culture Exam?

Due to a limited number of seats, the AP Chinese Language & Culture exam is considered a ‘Restricted Purchase Exam’ and is available for purchase through a structured purchase schedule. Payment will be made possible on IC for eligible students based on the linked timeline.

3) I am enrolled in an AP class at Lynbrook and have already followed my teacher’s directions to ‘join’ the class on my AP College Board portal. Do I still need to register/pay for the AP exam on IC?

Yes, you still need to register/pay in Infinite Campus. Joining the AP class on your AP College Board portal AND registering/paying on Infinite Campus are both necessary steps in getting an exam ordered for you.
