RE: *Cambridge Springs Jr/Sr High School Closure*

This week, CSHS has ten (10) known active positive COVID-19 cases and 4 individuals awaiting test results. Today, we have 56 students absent from school and 62 students absent due to quarantine. Additionally, the football, soccer, cheer and cross county teams are impacted. School staff are working to case investigate, contact trace and notify the impacted families.

At this time, a school closure is necessary. Cambridge Springs Jr/Sr High School is closed until Tuesday, September 14, 2021. All students must participate in virtual learning and log into Google Classroom daily.

All athletic practices and games (home and away) are postponed. CSHS athletics are shut down until Tuesday, September 14, 2021. **All games and practices for today, September 9, 2021, are cancelled.**

All families should closely monitor students for signs and symptoms of COVID-19. [Symptoms of Covid-19](#) may include fever or chills, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, or new loss of taste or smell. We strongly recommend that parents contact health care professionals if demonstrating any of the signs or symptoms outlined above.

It is our experience that the most effective COVID-19 mitigation strategy is keeping sick individuals out of our schools. **Students and staff that are sick, ill or unwell, must stay home from school.**
