Principal's Message

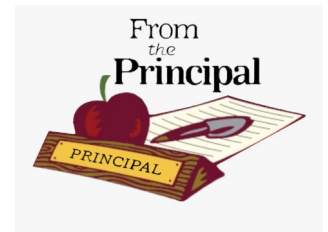
Dear Families,
