Hit or Miss

The numerical version of this game is usually played with 4 digits, but can also be played with 3 or any other number of digits.

On a sheet of paper, one player writes a 4-digit secret number. The digits must be all different. Then, the second player tries to guess their opponent's number.

If the matching digits are in their right positions, they are "hits", if in different positions, they are "misses". Example:

- Secret number: 4271
- Opponent's try: 1234
- Answer: 1 hit and 2 misses. (The hit is the "2", the misses are "1", "3" and "4".)
