Buffalo Seminary does not require a uniform. The SEM dress code exists to allow students freedom to express their individual style while also acknowledging SEM as an academic institution.

It is the responsibility of each student and her guardian(s) to check her attire before leaving for school. As a community, we strive to dress in a manner that supports a positive learning environment for all. Student attire will be checked each morning at the door.

Dress Code Quick Reference Chart:

Not Permitted
 Clothing or masks that advocate for a specific political position, reference illegal drugs, alcohol, or violence, or contain obscenity or hate speech Clothing with logos, words, and graphics Soiled, ripped, or torn clothing Visible undergarments, except for straps Strapless tops and dresses without a sweater or cardigan Tops that reveal a student's midriff Dresses/skirts/shorts less than fingertip length Leggings that are see-through Blankets or Pajamas Sweatpants and track pants Facial jewelry other than earrings and a single nose piercing Flip-flops, slippers, pool deck/shower shoes
Beanies, hats and baseball caps

• Clothing with words, logos, or graphics

New Changes to Dress Code

- Blue Jeans (free of rips and tears) are permitted every day of the week.
- Baseball caps, beanies and hats are permitted on Fridays only. Hoods are never permitted.
- Clothing with logos, words, and graphics are permitted on Fridays only.
- Coats are permitted if you are cold in the building.

Never Permitted - Clothing that advocates for a specific political position, references illegal drugs, alcohol, or violence, or contains obscenity or hate speech.
