

PERSONAL HYGIENE AND SAFETY MEASURES



- Masks are required (until September 17th) for students and staff in classrooms and on school buses when social distancing is not possible. CDC recommends universal indoor masking for all teachers, staff, students, and visitors to K-12 schools, regardless of vaccination status.
- Staff to monitor for signs and symptoms of illness.
- Continually teach and reinforce hygiene best practices including hand-washing.
- Require routine disinfection of classrooms and work areas and consistent cleaning expectations for staff.
- Routinely clean and sanitize bathrooms and all other common areas throughout the day in addition to the regular cleaning schedule.
- Provide sufficient cleaning supplies to all areas and hand sanitizing stations in classrooms and hightraffic areas.
- Provide hand sanitizing stations on each bus.
- Sanitize buses after every route and disinfect buses after morning and evening routes.
- Social distancing is encouraged indoors and where appropriate.



- Stagger use of communal spaces.
- Modified cafeteria procedures.
- Limit sharing of student supplies, equipment and technology in classrooms.
- Isolation and quarantine protocols practiced in accordance with CDC and GaDPH guidelines for individuals who test positive for COVID-19.

COMMUNICATION PROTOCOLS

CCS will provide appropriate communications when there is a positive case of COVID-19 identified in a school or classroom consistent with applicable law and privacy policies. Individual communications will be made to close contacts of a person who has tested positive as defined by and in accordance with GaDPH.

Notes from the Office:

Temporary changes in transportation may be arranged by sending a written note that includes the date(s) in which the change is in effect, the student's full name, the teacher's name and the type of change requested. An email, in place of a handwritten note, may also be sent to

prekattendance@calhounschools.org for Pre-K or

cpsattendance@calhounschools.org for K-2 or

cesattendance@calhounschools.org for 2-5.

For a student making a transportation change to or on buses, include the new address and the name of the adult to receive the child when delivered. For a student making a change to or within car riders/ carpool, include the name and school issued tag number of the adult making the pick-up. The note must be signed by a custodial parent/guardian or by someone identified on the child's information card to have permission to pick up the child. Changes in transportation must be made by 2:15 pm.



Thank you for taking the time to help your child(ren) memorize their car rider or carpool number. This will aid in speeding up the dismissal process.
