Rib Mountain Goals for 21-22 Submitted by Tammy Steckbauer, Principal

In our quest for continuous improvement, we have examined our student, family, and staff data and will be working to develop action steps to help us improve in the targeted areas. It's important that you know our goals and are aware of what we're trying to accomplish.

Student Engagement Survey Results

Last spring, we surveyed our fourth and fifth grade students. This survey has a target score of 80 which translates to "highly effective" practices. We have already begun to work on these areas through our Leader in Me program with our 21-22 theme: *Rib- Where every student is a leader!* It is our interest to work to find opportunities that will grow and cultivate a feeling of empowerment and leadership in every student.

Our three most significant areas according to students are as follows:

42pts.- I have the power to make a difference.

50pts.-I feel like an important member of my school.

57pts.-I have the chance to make a difference.

Parent School Perception Survey Results

Parents had an opportunity to participate in a survey last spring as well. This data has been collected over the last several years so we are able to see our results ebb and flow. While I'm proud that many of our results are very strong, we do see some areas in need of improvement. Those areas are listed below.

42%- I feel my opinions are taken into consideration regarding policy decisions. (This score has declined over the last few years: 100, 97, 65, and 42).

54.4%-I am satisfied with how our school responds to reported bullying incidents.

70.7%-The amount of homework given is appropriate.

73.4%- Teachers personalize instruction to meet my child's needs.

We are committed to being the best elementary school possible. We are committed to each and every child, and we will be sharing information with you to help outline our approach to these challenges. First and foremost, I will be working to address these parent engagement results through open communication. I believe the first step is to make sure we are all on the same page in terms of our understanding. Please watch for that information to be shared in upcoming newsletters.

Parents/guardians, you are your child's first and most important teacher! At any time, if you have information to share, tips and tricks to help motivate your child, or information to help us better understand your child's learning style and/or interests, we hope you'll share that with us.





practice being proactive about the things that are in your Circle of Control and working to improve those things. The more time you spend in your circle of control, the more improvement you will see.

Calling All Vendors!!!!



On behalf of the Rib Mountain Elementary School and PTO, we invite you to join us as a vendor at the annual Rib Mountain PTO Fall Bazaar. The event will be Saturday, November 13, 2021, from 8:00am – 3:00pm at Rib Mountain Elementary School located at 150801 Robin Lane.

If you are interested in joining us this year, please complete the enclosed **Vendor Registration Form** and return along with a **check** to the address below. Please make checks payable to Rib Mountain PTO. If you have provided an email address, you will receive confirmation by email. **We appreciate completed registrations and payment by Monday, September 20, 2021.**

Returning vendors will be given priority registration; however, it is expected that <u>all</u> vendors will meet the September 20th deadline for this to apply. A waiting list will be created for other interested vendors effective Tuesday, September 21, 2021. The waiting list will operate on a first-come, first serve basis. We reserve the right to limit the number of similar vendors to ensure an optimum sales opportunity; in particular, direct sales vendors. **Other specific space location requests** can be made, but please know that there is <u>no</u> guarantee they will be honored. This includes preferences regarding hallway spaces.

There will be no food pre-order form again this year. Food could be ordered and paid for the morning of the event and would be delivered to your booth.

We are excited to have you participate in our annual PTO/Rib Mountain Elementary Fall Bazaar and we appreciate your support! In an effort to increase foot traffic, we have invested more for advertising. We have also increased the number of vendor spaces available. In order to do that, we created spaces in our hallways. All spaces, regardless of their location, measure close to 60° ft. We have spaces in the gymnasium (10X6) = 60° ft. and we have spaces in the hallway that vary due to the width of the hallway:

$$(3.5 \times 17.5 \text{ ft.}) = 61.25^{\circ} \text{ ft.}$$
 $(4 \times 15 \text{ ft.}) = 60^{\circ} \text{ ft.}$ $(4.5 \times 13.5 \text{ ft.}) = 60.7^{\circ} \text{ ft.}$

We will fill the spaces in the gym first and then move to fill spaces in the hallway. As noted, if you prefer a certain sized hallway space to better accommodate your booth set up, you can indicate that on the registration form. While guarantees cannot be made, efforts to accommodate your wishes will be made. The best way to guarantee your wishes is to register and submit your payment early!

Rib Mountain PTO Fall Bazaar 2021 Vendor General Information

Show Hours: Advertised hours will be from 8:00am until 3:00pm. Please have your booth ready by 7:45am.

Setup & Tear down: Setup hours will be held on Friday, November 12th from 4:30pm – 6:30pm and on Saturday, November 13th starting at 6:45am. No early arrivals/setups will be allowed. Tear down will begin immediately at the close of the event and we ask that you be finished by 3:45pm.

Advertising: We will provide event advertising and a listing of vendors & crafters on various media outlets, City Pages, and radio stations.

Electricity: Limited spaces with access to an outlet are available. You must provide your own extension cords; cords must be in good condition. Painters tape may be used to secure any exposed cords. All tape used to cover cords must be removed at the end of the event by the vendor.

Vendors: We reserve the right to select all vendors and types of items sold at the event. Each vendor is responsible for his/her items the day of the event. Rib Mountain PTO is not responsible for any lost or stolen items or for equipment other than that supplied by the school and PTO. Vendor spaces are limited and are available on a first-come, first-serve basis for space location. We will do our <u>best</u> to accommodate space requests, but cannot guarantee that requests will be honored.

Parking: Vendors may park in the school parking lot near the gym. During setup and take down time periods, the rear gym doors will be open. (This is door #5 and it will be unlocked for your use.) Please don't block the entrance/exit/doorways with your vehicle. Please unload your items and then move your vehicle away from the building to make room for others to do the same. Thank you.

Food: Food, beverages, snacks, and baked goods will be on sale throughout the day. All proceeds benefit the school and our PTO. There will be no pre-order forms for food. Food items can be ordered and paid for the morning of the event and would be delivered to your booth between **11:30am-12:00 pm.**

Building Regulations: Absolutely NO smoking or alcoholic beverages will be permitted on school property. No concealed weapons or firearms of any kind are permitted. <u>Please retain from bringing pets into our school building.</u> It's too soon to know if we will be required to wear masks. Please come prepared in case it's a requirement. Thank you!

2021-2022 Wausau West Traveling Basketball

Wausau West Boys Basketball offers competitive traveling teams for boys in grades 3rd - 8th Grade. It is the goal of the Wausau West Boys Basketball program to create a fun and positive learning experience for our youth basketball players while still building players fundamental skills and developing a competitive mindset.

We are changing how we handle our Traveling Team Basketball Uniform situation. You will be purchasing your son's uniform and it is for them to keep and reuse throughout their years of playing Traveling Basketball. We highly suggest that you order the uniform a little bigger so that they get multiple years of use out of the uniform. Your uniform package that you will be purchasing includes a Jersey & Shorts along with a shooting shirt. Information and Pricing is listed below.

Season Length Fee - Financial assistance available if needed

3rd - 4th Grade: November - February \$125.00 (includes Uniform, shooting shirt, 5 Warrior Cards)

5th - 6th Grade: November - Early March \$150.00 (includes shooting shirt, 5 Warrior Cards)
7th - 8th Grade: January - March \$150.00 (includes shooting shirt, 5 Warrior Cards)

Family Discount:

1st child Cost = Price above which includes Shooting Shirt + Warrior cards
Per additional Child Cost = \$75 which includes Shooting Shirt

Program Structure

3rd - 4th Grade

- Team Split evenly and all players play in every game as evenly as possible
- Will play in 4 to 6 tournaments, with possible scrimmages throughout the season
- A select team will be formed after the last tournament is played, Select team will consist of 10 players who will be chosen by the Wausau West coaching staff. Select team will play in 1-2 additional tournaments.
- Season Runs from November February

5th - 6th Grade

- 5th grade will be split evenly and all players will play in every game, playing time will not always be equal.
- 6th grade team creation will be based on player skill level, if teams can be split evenly they will be. Playing time will not always be equal. Creation of teams will be decided by the Wausau West coaching Staff.
- Will play in 6 8 tournaments (around 20 games)
- Season runs November late February/Early March

7th - 8th Grade

- Teams will be divided based on Skill/Ability. Teams determined by Wausau West coaching staff.
- Will play in 6 8 tournaments (around 20 games)
- Season runs from November March.

<u>Practice Structure - Practice is mandatory</u>

- 3rd 5th grades will practice 2 times per week (Monday/Thursday or Tuesday/Thursday) 5:30-7:00 or 7:00-8:30
- 6th 8th grade will practice 2 times per week (Monday/Thursday or Tuesday/Thursday)- 5:30-7:00 or 7:00-8:30
- 6th 8th grade will also have a skills practice once a week, This will be combined with another team and/or grade


