SERVICE HOURS ARE DOCUMENTED & COUNTED FROM MARCH 1st TO FEBRUARY 28th.

Begin logging your hours on March 1st with the accompanying BROC Service Hours Log form and submit your completed form to Student Services no later than February 28th. Forms may be turned in earlier as needed. Late submissions or those without an authorized signature will not be accepted.

All participants logging 25+ hours receive a t-shirt. Participants who log enough hours to earn a President's Service award will receive a certificate, letter, and pin.

SERVICE HOURS GUIDELINES:

Eligible:

- ❖ Helping your Community
- ❖ Performing arts, plays and musicals.
- ❖ Managing a sports team
- ❖ Benefiting a community program

Not Eligible:

- ❖ Fundraising activities of any kind.
- ❖ Religious instruction
- ❖ Serving only family members
- ❖ Court ordered community service
- ❖ Proselytizing
