

You will have the option to select "in-person" or "virtual attendance via Teams" when registering. If you select virtual attendance, a Microsoft Teams link will be sent to you before the event. Transcript Request Form Class of 2022

When your student applies to a college or university, they need to request that their transcript be sent to that particular school. This should be done through the [Transcript Request Form](#). There is a \$3 fee per transcript that is sent. (Example: If your student applies to 5 colleges, then the fee is \$15.)

Instant Decision Days Class of 2022

Nazareth will be hosting an Instant Decision Day with [Holy Family University](#) on October 7th. Students who participate will be given an admission decision this day. Students should register by October 1st and complete an application to Holy Family University by October 4th. If your student is interested in registering, please have them fill out this [FORM](#).

Nazareth will be hosting an Instant Decision Day with [La Salle University](#) on October 12th. Students who participate will be given an admission decision this day. Students should register for this event and complete an application to La Salle University by October 7th. If your student is interested in registering, please have them fill out this [FORM](#).

Nazareth will be hosting an Interview Day with [Saint Joseph's University](#) on October 26th. Students who participate will not be given an admission decision, but they can speak with the admissions representative about their application to Saint Joseph's University, about the university, or about anything else they would like to discuss related to admissions.
