Covid-19 exposure

Dear CSHS Cheerleading and Soccer families,

All cheerleading and soccer coaching staff and players who attended practice on 9/8 are identified as a close contact to a positive COVID-19 case. We were notified that both teams have multiple individuals who are COVID positive. Both teams are quarantined through Sunday, September 19th.

Symptoms of COVID-19 may include fever or chills, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, or new loss of taste or smell. The PA Department of Health has established contact tracing protocols for all close contacts. We strongly recommend that parents contact health care professionals if demonstrating any of the signs or symptoms of COVID-19.


Depending on vaccination status all exposed individuals **must** do one of the following:

1. If vaccinated (individual can attend school)
 - a. Obtain a laboratory test from a healthcare provider AND wear a mask indoors until negative test results are received; OR
 - b. Wear a mask indoors through and including 9-19.

2. If unvaccinated (individual cannot attend school)
 - a. Quarantine through and including 9-19; OR
 - b. Obtain a negative laboratory test from a healthcare provider performed on or after 9-13. They can return to the building on 9-16 with negative test results.

This past week, Cambridge Springs has experienced a drastic increase in positive cases. It is our experience that the most effective Covid-19 mitigation strategies is keeping sick individuals out of our school. **I implore all individuals who are sick, ill, or unwell to stay home.** We need to work together to keep kids safe and healthy to maximize face to face in school instruction.
