| Closed Campus | Cleveland ISD campuses will remain closed to families and visitors prior to Labor Day. The district reserves the opportunity to extend this timeline dependent upon COVID circumstances. |
| Masks/Face Coverings | Masks and Face Coverings are optional this year, but are highly encouraged. |
| Positive Cases | Individuals who test positive for COVID-19 MUST stay home for 10 days. Symptomatic Individuals - quarantine begins on the first day of symptoms Asymptomatic - quarantine begins on the first day of the positive test result State and local days will be used from an individual's leave bank. |

| Suspected Cases | Faculty and staff are encouraged to self screen and not report to work should they exhibit symptoms |

| Remote Conferencing (Instruction) | Students who test positive will engage in Remote Conferencing (Instruction) • Pre-Kindergarten - 5th grade: Canvas coursework • 6th-12th grades: Edgenuity |

| Close Contact | There will be NO contact tracing for students, faculty and staff • Cleveland ISD will conduct contact tracing should circumstances deem it an appropriate action to |

| Individuals who consider themselves close contacts: MAY CHOOSE to self-quarantine - Individuals who exhibit no symptoms must quarantine for 10 days Individuals who exhibit symptoms or test positive while in quarantine must follow the Return to Work Criteria below Individuals who choose to take a COVID test while in quarantine and receive a negative result on day 5 or 6 of the quarantine may return on day 7 |
| Fully vaccinated individuals are NOT considered close contact |
| State and local days will be used from an individual's leave bank |
| Employees who are considered close contacts and continue to work MUST rapid test periodically for 10 days prior to the start of their work day. This can be done by our rapid testing team in CISD. Information is on the CISD homepage under Staff COVID-19 Resources . Employees will test on day 1, day 5, and day 10. This must be scheduled with the appropriate rapid testing site as indicated in the resources linked above. |
| Should the district become aware of an individual considered close contact through another public agency, the campus/department will notify the parents of the student or the individual faculty or staff member or campus visitor |
| Symptomatic with No COVID-19 Test: 10 days since the onset of symptoms AND fever free for 24 hours • Should an individual test several days into their quarantine and test positive, their days begin with the date of the onset of their symptoms. |
| Asymptomatic: 10 days since the positive test result |
| Your campus COVID Coordinator can support you in determining your return to work date. |
| Cleveland ISD will continue to pursue and promote vaccination clinic opportunities for students, families, faculty, and staff Faculty and staff will continue to promote good hygiene Cleveland ISD will continue our COVID cleaning practices in all buildings |
