




REMINDER PARENTS: NO CARS IN THE BUS ROUND ABOUT

Health Reminders

Health Reminders

Please monitor the health and well-being of your student each morning. Do not send your student to school if their are experiencing COVID-like symptoms which, according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention are:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

If your child has any of these symptoms they must stay at home. In order to return to school your child must be 24 hours fever free without the use of fever-reducing medication(s) and have one of the following to return to school:

- Your medical provider has determined your child has an alternative clinical diagnosis other than COVID-19 and has cleared your child to return to school.
- A negative COVID-19 diagnostic test completed.
- Your child has completed a quarantine of at least 10 calendar days from the first onset of symptoms.

Rapid COVID-19 Testing

Rapid COVID-19 Testing

During the 2021-22 school year, District 129 will continue to participate in BinaxNOW's approved COVID-19 testing program. This fast-acting antigen test is approved by the FDA and delivers results in 15 minutes. Having a consent and waiver form on file allows our health office to offer free BinaxNOW testing for your child in the event that they become symptomatic during the school day, while in attendance at school. Using the results of the test, we can then provide you with the necessary information to determine next steps to protect your family.

Should you wish to participate in the program, please complete the consent and waiver form linked below and get the form to the nurse at your child's school. Those who completed the form during the 2020-21 school year do not have to submit another form.

Throughout the school year, all students within District 129 actively take part in various school safety procedures such as evacuation, severe weather, and ALICE drills.
